Mother Teresa apologizes for 'trouble'

CALCUTTA, India (AP)-M Teresa's condition may be critical, but she felt well enough today to tell
doctors they were doing too much for doctors they were doing too much for
her. I am giving you so much trouble.
I am so sorry. God bless you all, for Jesus, for the poorest of the poor,"
she said, according she said, according to A.K.
Chatterjee, director of the B.M. Birla Heart Research Center.
Mother Teresa's heart was stable,
her kidney function was under control her kidney function was under controi
and her lungs were and her lungs were getting clearer, week and a half after the 86 -year-old week and a haif after the 86-year-old
nun suffered a mild heart attack.
Her heartbeat Her heartbeat was irregular, he
said, and she continued to use an said, and she continued to use an
oxygen mask. Mother Teresa's doctors performed an angioplasty last week, removing blockages from two arteries, and they remained conc
about her lungs and kidneys. about her lungs and kidneys.
"Even though there are sig slight improvement, we continue to be very concerned. She is still critical and not out of danger," her doctors said in a statement.
Still, they were optimistic she
eventually would recover enough to eventually would recover enough to
return to her work leading the Missionaries of Charity, an order thet
runs 517 orphanages, homes for the runs 517 orphanages, homes for the
poor. AIDS hospices and other poor, Acent hospices and ouner
charity yenter around the world.
The 1979 Nobel Peace Prize inner has been hospitaalized since

fourth time in the hospital this year, the second for heart problems. Two others were for injuries from falls. On Friday, doctors performed the
angioplasty, which went so well they angioplasty, which went so well they
thought they would be able to begin drug treatments for her irregular heartbeat on Sunday.
But after feeling well enough work, Mother Teresa slipped back into critical condition Sunday. She began showing signs of recovery on Monday.
"She is an exceptional person," at the hospital, told reporters Monday. "Partly with her willpower and partly with the expertise and the treatment at the center, she will cover soon.

Dr. Patricia Aubanel, one of seven ocid Mother Teresa's kidneys not working well because her hear had been malfunctioning for several months. Mother Teresa suffered
chest infection and pneumonia in August, further weakening her lungs.

## Hanspard gets Doak Walker Award

DALAS (AP) S. Slatisically, Byron Hanspard wasn'teven the best
running back in his conference this season, but Doak Walker Award voters looked past the numbers. On Monday, the Texas Tech junior
was honored as the best running back was college foothall.
Hanspard- only the sixth running back in NCAA history to rush for more than 2,000 yards in a seasonedged fellow juniors Troy Davis of Darnell Autry for the award. Hanspard ran for 2,084 yards, but Davis topped him for the Big 12
rushing title with a national-best rushing uatde with a national-best
2,185 yards. Autry was the Big Ten rushing champion with 1,386 yards and 15 touchdowns on 263 carries. Autry and Davis were expected to have big years coming off sophomore
seasons that made them Heisman Trophy finalists. Hanspard was merely seen as an up-and-comer after
rushing for 1,374 yards last year rushing for 1,374 yards last year.

## Spray raises controversy

Politicians and citizens groups are hailing the drive to legalize the spray - which contains compressed oils
from hot peppers - as a cheap, easy way for ordinary citizens to protect themselves from criminals. But others, police among them, worry the spray is giving people a
false sense of security or worse, is being bought by criminals for use against their victims.
Despite the controversy, more and sprays legal for public purchase sprays legal for public purchase.
"Each time a woman carries her pepper spray in her hand as she walks
through some dark parking lot, she through some dark parking lot, she
feels more secure," said Honolulu feels more secure," said Honolulu
Councilman John Henry Felix, sponsor of a bill to legalize the sale of pepper spray to ordinary citizens. expected this week to make permanent the legal personal use of pepper spray for self-defense.
"Every senior citize. who sits at a bus stop at night feels more secure
because he has pepper spray," Felix said.

Police have used the spray for years to subdue suspects. A blast to the eyes, nose or throat causes an
intense stinging that lasts for about three minutes and is often preferable to a nightstick or handgun. Sale of the spray is now legal in
