Holiday celebrations can be meaning and significance of each onderful opportunities for children to learn about the traditions and
values that are cherished parts of people's lives. But many early childhood professionals wonder what holidays to celebrate in the program
or classroom and how to respect the cultures represented by all children. Many parents, too, wonder why or why they discourage any celebraion at all. The National Association for the Education of Young Children believes that decisions about what ogether by teachers, parents and ocgener by teachers, parents and comfortable when both have expressed their views and understand
how a decision has been reached. The how a decision has been reached. The
important thing for all to remember is that when planning activities, the rules of zood practice eontinue to apply: Aretre activities meaningfut
to the children? Are their needs and interests being met? Is the activity a valuable use of the child's time? Teachers may survey families at the beginning of the year to determine
what holidays to celebrate. They may even ask the children to create their own holiday to help them learn the concepts that underlie such valued traditions. In any case, holiday
celebrations are just one way for programs and families to work together to create developmentally and culturally appropriate learning Here are some signs of good
practice in celebrating holidays: ${ }^{*}$ Parents and teachers ask themselves why children should learn
about the holiday? Is it developmentally appropriate for those in the group? Why is it important to specific children and families? specific children and families in the spoup. This helps children understand holiday activities in the context of people's daily lives. Children should
have the chance to explore

whose families' beliefs whose families' beliefs donot permit Families should take part in creating satisfactory alternatives for the child within the classroom.
*Focus is on meaningful ways to celebrate holidays without spending money. Families may find certain of commercialization and the media pressure to buy gifts. Teachers can help by showing children that very special and ces and gifts are jery special, and cel
joyful without gifts.

Larkin learns he was killed in an automobile accident, and an experiment brought himb beck to life as a cybernetic being implanted with falsified human memories:
"It's a story that people can really relate to because, at some point, we all feel pretty secure with what we have, but often wonder if the grass is greener on the other side of the hill." says Michael Vickerman, the movie's screenwriter.

The story's premise isn't as farfetched as you might think
"It's possible, when you're talking about someone who's still alive, being rebuilt with synthetic implants," says Selmer Bringsjord, an associate profes. sor who heads the Minds \& Machines Program at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, N.Y
"We're already starting to see implants in terms of antificial retinas, so we are moving in that direction."
Larkin's search for his identity turns into a struggle for survival when the government realizes he knows about the experiment and sets out to terminate him. Larkin then kidnaps the woman pretending to be his wife (Suzy Amis) and forces her to divulge the truth.
