Bands of thugs descended with knives and axes on four western Algeria villages, slaying people at sunset Tuesday whie they were breaking their Ramadan fasts, the newspaper Liberte, citing witnesses, reported today. Armed with knives and axes, the unidentified atackers hacked their children to death, Liberte said.
NETANYAHU MAY CITE BUDGETARY PROBLEMS JERUSALEM (AP) - Preoccupied with a budget battle Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu was considering asking U.S. envoy Dennis Ross to postpone a visit to the region.

While Netanyahu's aides said he may ask Ross to delay his visit to discuss Israeli-Palestinian issues, Palestinians complained Friday that the peace process is being held hostage to Israeli domestic politics. And, they say,
Netanyahu's concessions to Jewish settlers - designed to win backing for his budget - are a serious blow to hopes for peace.

## History books omit interesting items


#### Abstract

Often what wedon'tfind in history books is muchmore interessing than what we do find -- especiaily when the history involves your family. A few years ago, hhe Sevier County Historical Society put out h history book about their southwest Alcansas county. My ancestors played a prominent book about their southwest Arkansast role in the early days of the county. The City of Hereford will begin on January 1st with a new operating policy concerning the collection of debris other than household garbage. For the past two years, the City has routinely collected all manner of material from the alleys including refrigerators, TVs, mattresses, carpet, furniture and miscellaneous material. This has caused the City to expend significant sums on manpower and equipment costs.
JUNK:
Effective January 1st, we will only pick up items in the alleys during four times each year. The first period for collection will be January 5th through January 9th After that period, we will only collect household garbage placed in the dumpsters and yard waste, such as leaves, limbs, grass, etc.
Residents can take the material to the landfill and desposit it without paying a fee, provided they show water bill, rent receipt or some proof of residency.
The next date for collection will be in April. Please help us contain the cost for solid waste collection by cooperating in this effort.


TIRES: The Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission will officially end paymen for the collection and recycling of tires on December 31, 1997. This has caused the City to have to modity the manner in which we handle the tires delivered to the landifill. Beginning January 1st, the City will be required to pay a fee for the disposal of each tire. The proposed fee will be $\$ 1.50$ per tire for passenger and light trucks - up to 17.5 inch rim diameter tires. The fee for up to 12.00 series tires will be $\$ 5.50$. The fee for farm equipment tires will be $\$ 10.50$. These fees will be charged whether you are a resident of he City or not because the fee we have to pay for handling is not included in your monthly garbage collection fee. We are reluctant to charge these extra fees, but feel we have little recourse after the state ceased its
subsidy in this process.

Unsure how to write a Classified Ad that will ge results? Follow these pointers and you'll soon have an empty space in your storage room and cash in your pocket.

For starters, look at ads which offer the same item/ products. Get a sense of going rates and ideas for how to make exactly what you're selling: "Dining room set, maple, six chairs." Then, remember these hints.
-Give the price. A newspaper consultant says 70 percent of classified readers won't respond to an ad with no price.
-Use key words to describe what you're selling. The key words for a car are make, model, year, body style, color mileage and price. If it's a house, key words are location, type
of construction, number of bedrooms and baths, and condi-
tion. --Don't use abbreviations. It's tempting to abbreviate and save money if ads are billed by the line. Brand ads are billed by the words, so spell them out so readers won't be confused trying to figure out abbreviations.

Don't be misleading. Think accurate and factual when you write Be sure to include a phone number and the best times to reach you.

## Scattering Dad starts well, then vanishes into thin air

A widow struggles to overcome her agoraphobia and fulfill her late husband's final wish in Scattering Dad, a well-meaning but uneven comedy-drama premiering Sunday, Jan. 4, on CBS. For years, Dotty (Oscar winner Olympia Dukakis) has suffered severe panic attacks whenever she tries to The recent
The recent death of her husband, Hiram (Andy Griffith), has left her feeling even more unsettled.
Shortly after his funeral, Hiram's spirit visits Dotty and reminds her that she promised to scatter his ashes at Cathedral Rocks, a nearby desert vacation spot they visited once with their daughters, Molly and Taylor (Lucinda Jenney, Michelle Rene Thomas). Overcome by feelings of obligation, Dotty forces herself to take tentative steps out into the world and begins the journey to fulfill her late husband's request.
Alarmed by Dutty's absence, her daughters join her near the end of her trip. giving the three women the chance
to dispel years of tension among them. The story by actress Barbara Bosson (Murder One), who adapted it with director Joan Tewkesbury, begins strongy with poignant scenes of loss and re membered love filled with evocative American Indian imagery.
Dukakis and Griffith are very touching in their scenes together, and adorable Elaine Miles (Marilyn from Northern Exposure) is a welcome addition in her role as a mystic.
Dukakis is capable of making viewers feel Dotty's panic as she takes her first agonizing steps into the yard.
The journey begins promisingly enough, but when the three women join together for the final leg, Scattering Dad collapses into predictability. Jenney and Thomas are competent actresses, but the TV movie's writer have given their characters such contrived "problems" to complain abou that most viewers will lose interest in them.
A scattering of sentimentalists may find solace in Scattering Dad, but despite the efforts of Dukakis, it ultimate ly disintegrates into ashes.
