## AG files lawsult over automobile repair claims

AUSTIN - Texas Attorney General John Cornyn last week flled lawsuits against 16 polityholders on auto repair claims. Named in the lawsuits are State Farm, Allstate, Farmers, USAA, Progressive County
Mutual, Farm Bureau, State Mutual, Farm Bureau, State and County American County Mutual, Home State, Count Mutual, Sentry, Maryland Casualty, Consumors County Mutual and CNA insurance compa
nies.
The lawsuits allege the companies violate Texas law by taking illegal deductions for policyholders' repair claims.
"Deduction for betterment
"Deduction for betterment or depreciation on policyholders' auto repair claims has been
an Industry custom in Texas," Cornyn said. "But the personal auto insurance policy does not allow it. Several companies have informed us that they have recently stopped reducing
claim payments for betterment, and I applaud this step.
"However, I intend to make sure that policyholders get the refunds they are entitled to and that all companies play by the same
"Betterment" is an insurance industry term for increasing the value of a vehicle by paying to repair it with better or newer parts. The standard Texas auto policy does not
allow for such a deduction, and a recent Austin Court of Appeals opinion indicates that these deductions are not permitted. The lawsuits ask the court for permanent injunctions to end all betterment-relate against their policyholders, and ask for civil penalities to be paid to the state of up to as Insurance Code.

fancy animals. That's why passersby in these parts see a passersby in these parts see a
trio of shaggy, two-humped
camels stepping nonchalantly camels stepping nonchalantly around a snow-covered New
England hillside. The Tregellys Fiber Farm in the Berkshire Hills of Massachusetts is raising Bactrian camels and yaks, as well as
more common critters such as more common critters such as
llamas, Icelandic sheep and Angora goats, for their wool. "There's a real market niche for our products," said Jody
Cothey, who owns the farm Cothey, who owns the farm
with her husband, Ed. "It provides us with a way to reclaim this old farm.
The Cotheys' place on Hawk Mountain is an eye-catching
evolution in a state where evolution in a state where
colonial woolen mills launched the nation's textile industry. Most of the yarns spun
from the exotic wools are col from the exotic wools are col
ored with organic dyes in the basement of the farmhouse by their business partner. They then go to the fashion de
signer market or folks handy signer market or folks hand
enough to knit their own ver sions of a designer sweater. Jody Cothey says she envisioned a place in the country
with room for their dogs and with room for their dogs and
cats when they first bought the overgrown former potato farm. The farm's name is Cor nish for "Hidden Homestead." Her husband added to their
assortment of animals when he traded a wood chipper for two milk goats. Then he came home from a local fair with some Angora goats and dis-
covered he had a knack for covered he had a knack for
weaving wool as well as fish ing nets.
And then they expanded from llamas to alpacas, yak
"We were middle-agers ba sically starting over with a new life," she said.
Native to the frigid Mongolian desert and equipped wit ing wool, the Bactrian camels aren't at all bothered by the cold, said Ed, who was a com-
mercial fisherman. It is the mercial fisherman. It is the
soft undercoat, shed during warmer weather, that is spun into yarn, he said.

The Agriculture Department withdrew its inspectors from the Supreme Beef Processors Inc. plant in Dallas Nov. 30, effectively closing the facility, but was forced to send them
back when a judge granted a temporary restraining order The when a judge granted a temporary restraining order Supreme beef to the federal school lunch program. Supreme Beef was ne of the program's largest suppliers until USDA cut off purchases at the same time it tried to close the facility.
USDA officials said Monday that the plant has modified its pathogen control plan to prevent salmonella contamination. Inspectors "will closely monitor the implementation" and conduct another round of salmonella testing, said
Thomas Billy, administrator of USDA's Food Safety and Inspection Service.
Supreme Beef says that it was not responsible for the salmonella and that the government had no right to shut it down. The company has no plans to drop a lawsuit against president, Steven F. Spiritas, Supreme Beef had agreed to make the changes it is making before USDA tried to shut the plant down, he said.
