## There's no bag limit on the spectacle of goose hunting

The weatherman's prognostication that this was to turn into a warm day hadn't made much of an plentiful already, and though it was from the south west--a portent of the mild weather that had been forecast, the steadily-stiffening breeze was on the raw and shiver-evoking Brian Van Zee and I had set the goose spread so efficiently white parkas and waiting amidst the decoys as shooting tim arrived.
As is the rule of nature, had we been late, the geese would have been early. We were early--and this day the geese would be casual risers. So, we waited as the coating of hoarfrost that
frequently accompanies sunrise formed on the decoys, and the Irequently accompanies sunrise formed on the de
velocity of the wind gusts continued to increase. velocity of the wind gusts conthued towincrease.
Once the sun brightened from the glowing orange-and-red of dawn tofull daylight, skeins of geese strung themselves across the northern sky. Some undulated our way against the wind, a mixture of dark and light forms characterized by their shortstroke wingbeats. When the snows among hecks wheced
sky. played for the oncoming flocks the plastic song of goose seduction, once we thought they were close enough to hear and appreciate the plaintive hails and clucks that our coldnumbed lips evoked from the cylinders we blew into. Our job was to convince feathered skeptics that they should abundant scattered morsels of corn. The geese gave their instantaneous critique of our music.

Pan of a large, poor family headed by a single mother (Lifford), Loretta Clai borne was hom partially blind Unabie to walk or talk until age 4 , she endures the predictable taunts and humiliation for her mild mental retardation while growing up, finding her bliss at last in unning.
Her discovery of that talent happily coincides with the establishment of the Special Olympies program, which genunely changes her life, She receive the $\mathbf{0 9 6}$ Arthur Ashe Award for Courage at the ESPY Awards.
It's a story that easily could tip over into mawkishness or sentimentality, yer it never does, thanks to striking perfor. mances by ifs stars and bracing diree ion by Grant.
