Prices may be up about 10 cents a pound because armers in the 20 -county southeast Georgia region where State agriculture floures indicate Georgia farmers 14,918 acres of Vidalias this year, compared with 15,500 acres in 1999 and 16,000 in 1998.
Farmers usually sell Vidalias to grocers at about 50
ents a pound, and the consumer typically pays around 69 cents. Consumer prices this year could go as high as 79 cents a pound.
But University of Georgia extension economist Bill
Thomas said prices should also stabilize, "Hopefully it will help maintain a steadier price at the grocery store," he
said. The first crop of Vidalias will also likely hit the shelves a ittle later this year.
