percent in the past 10 years

Texas has risen an estimated
58 percent. Texas' average
state employee salary is $\$ 7,656$
less than the average state
employee salary for the other
nine most populous states.
Turnover among the state's
25,000 employees cost Texas
between $\$ 127$ million and $\$ 254$
million in 1999 .
The report recommends be-
tween $\$ 30$ milling and $\$ 56$
million in changes for the
biennium to help reduce costs
associated with turnover.
The report proposes that the
salary range for the state's
schedule Ag and B employees
be adjusted to more accurately
reflect similar positions in the
private sector even though
state employees still would
fall 7 percent behind.

Quail aficionados want funding to study decline of bobwhites, blues

This long-term decline has quail enthusiasts like Rollins, state agencies, and conservation organizations so concermed that they plan to present a
$\$ 3.7$ million appropriations request before the 76th. State Legislature in 2001, asking for a study of the quail decline in Texas. Proposed is an appropriation of $\$ 1.85$ million in each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003 to fund research, Extension, and landowner incentives to reverse he quail decline in Texas.
Rolinins says bobwhites have especially declined across their U.S. range
during the past 15 years. Their plight is so critical that some scientists are during the past 15 years. Their plight is so critical that some scientists are
predicting that bobwhites will be extinct in parts of the Southeast by 2005 . According to Rollins, Texas remains a final frontier for wild bobwhite populations, but even in Texas, their numbers have been declining at an larming rate

Texas range during the past decade songbird populations are similarly declining, according to Rollins.
" Bobwhites serve as a barometer of changes in other grassland bird
populations. Management that improves quail populations will also benefit

Michael Richards has said all along that he won't be playing Kramer in his new series.
That it will be difficult to keep that in mind while watching The Michael Richards Show, which premieres Tuesday, Oct. 24, on NBC, is in no small way a compliment to the actor's physical gifts. The three-time Emmy winner can get as much mileage out of a pratcan get as much mileage out of a prat-
fall, bumble or double-take as anyone fall, bumble or double-take as anyone on teievision. But whiie Kramer was
over the top, Richards' new character, private detective Vic Nardozza, is a bit more subdued. It's like watching Kramer Lite.
"It would be nice if we could make him an American inspector Clouseau," Richards says, referring to the work of the late Peter Sellers, one of his comedy influences.
Watching Nardozza crack a case is a bit like watching Dudley Do-Right do the same. Both are lawmen without a the same. Both are lawmen without a
clue who somehow always manage to clue who som

Not that Nardozza, much like Richards, doesn't get help. "I realized more than ever the necessity of having
a strong supporting cast. That's the a stron g supporting cast. That' s
trademark of any show that works."
The confused PI is partnered with a brand-new agent, played by relative newcomer Amy Farrington, bes known for a small guest role on anoth er NBC show, ER. She joins a cas filled with veterans, including Tin Meadows (Saturday Night Live, Ladie: Man), Bill Cobbs (The Others, I Stil Know What You Did Last Summer
and William Devane (Knots Landing). and William Devane (Knots Landing).
Richards has a certain disdain fo most of today's dialogue-driven come dies despite his ties to Seinfeld, whicl was a real groundbreaker in that area. "Most of the comedies that I watch to-
day, they're talking-head comedies Good, funny patter between them all, but I like to do funny, and I intend to do that with this show," he says. What makes it all the more interesting is that he, along with three former Seinfeld writers, has created a show that thrives on irony, an intelligen quality missing from many comedies. Examples: Nardozza spends 20 min utes of each episode clueless before making some magical leap of logic that solves the case; the firm's muscleman is 65 years old; and Meadows plays a recovering Peeping Tom who not surprisingly, is very good with surveillance and video equipment.
And then there's Devane's character the owner of the agency. He's the one who should be the most worried about his befuddled employee, but he seems to be the only one who knows he has a good detective on his hands.
If The Michael Richards Show has one glaring weakness, it's the charac ers who surround Nardozza. What nade Kramer work was his self-serving and self-important friends. His enrance brought a change of pace and a resh perspective to a scene. Here Nardozza is the self-indulgent one, leaving the others to wonder how he can be so egotistical.
That this angle doesn't work as well in a farce is a small consideration giv en all the reported problems this series has had, including rewrites, reshoots nd cast changes. The writing is funny Richards still gets laughs with his conortions alone, and Devane and Cobbs are both particularly effective in their upporting roles.
NBC certainly has faith in the program. The Michael Richards Show will lead off the network's strong Tuesday block of comedy.
