Hereford Economic Development Corp. directors are expected to discuss a pair of projects that could broaden the Deaf Smith County tax base - if all the pieces come together.

At the meeting, which will begin at 4:30 p.m. Wednesday in the commission chamber at City Hall, the directors will discuss terms of a financial package for Swiss Girl Dairies and possible HEDC incentives for construction of Vilias of the Southwest, an assisted living center that would be developed by Oller Engineering Inc.

After a 45-minute, closed-door session July 28, the HEDC directors authorized executive not necessarily be capped at \$3 million. Money director Don Cumpton to begin contract negotiations with John Hafliger, a former Hereford resident who now lives in Canyon, about a a herd of approximately 2,500 head of cattle, package that would include a guaranteed loan and to cover costs of applying for, processing

Swiss Girl Dairies, in Deaf Smith County. Hafliger has been involved in the dairy industry for several years, operating dairies in Artesia, N.M., and a small one near Canyon. He also owns a small facility in the area that is leased to an operator.

HEDC to eye financial packages

Initial proposals called for the HEDC to guarantee a possible \$3 million loan for a ,500-head dairy cow facility.

Cumpton said the dairy would add about \$3 million to the county's tax base, bring in 18-25 jobs and possibly open the door for more dairies and support industries to move to the Hereford area.

It was hoped the funding for the venture would be provided by local banks and would would be used to purchase up to 640 acres for the dairy, construction of the complex to handle to construct a dairy, operating under the name and acquiring all the necessary state and

federal permits, which would allow the dairy to begin operations.

The cost of the dairy herd, feed or any moveable inventory or equipment is not covered under this agreement.

Hafliger will be responsible for submitting plans and specifications to the HEDC and all governing authorities. The agreement calls for all contract, sub-contract, vendors and materials to come from Deaf Smith County businesses

The directors also will discuss financial incentives for construction of the assisted living center.

The developer reportedly looked at the former Golden Plains Nursing Center, but decided it would be more economical to build his own complex and is considering other sites in Hereford for purchase.

If the assisted living complex is built, Cumpton said it could mean 10-12 new jobs, plus \$1.5 million for the county tax base.

ECONOMY Consumers keep their wallets open, increase spending

WASHINGTON (AP) — In more signs that the economy has yet to slow, consumer spending posted a strong rebound in June after two months of lackluster growth, while manufacturing activity remained steady in July.

The Commerce Department said spending rose by 0.5 percent in June, a slightly betterthan-expected gain following smaller increases of just 0.2 percent in April and 0.3 percent in

The National Association of Purchasing Managers said that its production index remained at 51.8 percent in July, ending a four-month decline in a gauge of future factory activity. A reading above 50 percent is viewed as indicating manufacturing will continue to grow.

The rebound in consumer spending outstripped American workers' gain in incomes, which were up 0.4 percent in June. That was in line with analysts' expectations and was a slight improvement from a 0.3 percent income advance in May. The Commerce Department said that construction spending fell 1.7 percent in June to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of \$800 billion. It marked the third consecutive monthly decline after decreases of 0.2 percent in May and 1.7 percent in April. It was the longest stretch of weakness since a similar three-month drop from April to June last year and reflected weakness reflected declines in all areas of building. Residential construction was down 1.4 percent; construction of non-residential buildings was off 1.1 percent, despite a slight rise in office construction, and government construction fell a sharp 4.4 percent, led by a big 9.7 percent fall in school construction. The June rebound in consumer spending was a further sign that the economic slowdown many economists have been expecting has yet to materialize. Last Friday, the government reported that the overall economy, as measured by the gross domestic product, was growing at an annual rate of 5.2 percent in the second quarter, even better than the 4.8 percent growth posted in the first three months of this year. That report has raised new concerns that the Federal Reserve will likely feel the need to boost interest rates further when Fed policymakers next meet on Aug. 22. The central bank has already increased short-term borrowing costs six times over the past 13 months in an effort to slow economic growth and keep inflation in check.

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Mixing politics and patriotism, Republicans turned to a trio of wartime heroes to offer convention testimonials for Texas Gov. George W. Bush - untested

John McCain, one-time GOP presidential nominee Bob Dole and retired Gen. Norman Schwarzkopf, commander of the war against. Iraq, stepped for-

ward for the second night of the McCAIN Republican's convention gala. Bush's McCain came with a message of former rival unity and reconciliation, saying speak in a prepared speech "it is my time to serve" his former rival.

Delegates wildly cheered another veteran, retired Gen. Colin Powell, as he praised Bush on Monday night for bridging racial divides and improving schools in Texas. But Powell also took Républicans to task for missing no opportunity to "roundly and loudly condemn affirmative action."



PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Kaycee Kendall's friends were heading to Cancun, Mexico, for their high school senior trip this summer. She had her mind set on Philadelphia.

Making it to the Republican National Convention was her goal, and now the 18-year-old is getting a taste of big-time politics as an alternate delegate from Refugio.

Kendall, who plans to attend the University of Texas at Austin as a freshman in the fall, is the youngest member of the Texas delegation.

"I've been a Republican for as long as I can remember - cut my teeth on politics," she said Monday. "I was born in '81. ... I've been a Republican ever since."

She got involved in county-level politics as a teen-ager, serving as secretary of her county convention.

Powell said the GOP must reach out to minorities — "and not just during an electionyear campaign. My friends, if we're serious about this, it must be a sustained effort."

Bush, slowly making his way to Philadelphia on a bus trip through five states, tantalized the convention with a brief speech, beamed to the convention hall by satellite from Westerville, Ohio. Ahead in the polls, Bush said he was "traveling through states that Democrats won in the last few elections. But not this time. Not this year." He will lay claim to the nomination Thursday night.

The governor also hinted that Powell, the only black to serve as chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, would get a job in his administration. Powell is a leading candidate to be Bush's secretary of state. "I hope his greatest service to America might still lie ahead," the governor said.

Powell, appearing on CNN's "Larry King Live," said he was "not trolling for a job." But he also said that "of course I would consider a cabinet position or any position in the government that a president was to offer me." He said he had not discussed the matter with Bush or his staff.

On ABC's "Good Morning America" show Tuesday, Powell said that same consideration would be given to any job offer from Democrat Al Gore should he win the presidency.

"If he were the president, I would have to take it under serious consideration," Powell said, referring to Gore. "I've had conversations with President Clinton like this. I elected not to accept some of the offers that were out there but you always have to listen when a president comes to you ...

Democrats tried to deflate the impact of Powell's address and steal attention from the convention. Civil rights leader Jesse Jackson said there was a

The 90-year-tradition is on hold for two years after last year's deadly collapse that killed 12 Aggies.

Monday afternoon, two members of the student group Keep the Fire Burning met privately with Southerland for about one hour to discuss their efforts to organize an

off-campus bonfire.

After the meeting, Joe Dyson, one of the group's board members, said his orga-nization is only investigating the possibility of holding a safe bonfire off campus.

Keep the Fire Burning has been talking to engineers, security companies, fire safety officials and lawyers about an

off-campus bonfire. The 2 million pound bonfire stack collapsed during con-struction on Nov. 18. Twelve Aggies died and 27 others were injured, some severely.

In June, it was announced the tradition would continue but not until at least 2002 and not without major changes, including far greater univer-sity supervision and a profes-sionally engineered design.

The university's administration is trying to discourage the students from pursuing the idea, said A&M spokes-man Keith Randall.

Officials warned students any kind of accident at an off campus bonfire, could forever ruin the tradition.

Soldiers begin firefighter training

FORT HOOD, Texas (AP) — Soldiers left the largest Army post in the free world on Tuesday to fight a battle that cannot be won with a gun.

About 50 large fires covering 537,791 acres over 10 states prompted the U.S. Army to add Texas soldiers to thousands of mostly federally paid firefighters and who have been battling blazes in grasslands and forests since May.

"With so many wildfires going on, there just isn't enough manpower," said Sven Klassen, a fire captain with the California Department of Forestry and Fire Prevention who came to Fort Hood to give soldiers a crash course.

Klassen and officials from the California and U.S. forest services accompanied the 500 soldiers to Idaho where they will get hands-on experience battling wildfires before heading to Payette National Forest near McCall, Idaho.

Texas Ranger investigate El Paso PD

EL PASO, Texas (AP) — The district attorney said he wants Texas Rangers' assistance in an investigation of the El Paso Police Department.

Jaime Esparza, who would not disclose details of the probe, said it involves "criminal matters," according to a report for Tuesday's El Paso Times.

Ranger Buster Collins referred mestions about the matter back to Esparza.

The DA said independent scrutiny of the Police Department will add public confidence to the criminal justice system.

"Having an outside agency investigate the areas I asked them to look into is appropriate under the circumstances," Esparza said.

The investigation is the one of several involving the troubled agency.

Recently, city police said they were investigating how reporters obtained a police document containing allegations against Police Chief Carlos Leon's former administrative assistant.

Police also recently began an investigation into the alleged mishandling of rent money from the Texas Commission for the Blind.





Rodriguez has been employed with TxDOT since 1983. In his spare time, he plays in the band Algo Simple which just recorded a CD for Hacienda Records.








"I thought very seriously about calling the bellman and telling him to come get my luggage and then flying home," Brogna said. The AL East-leading New



Study finds drinking protects diabetics

DALLAS - Two new studies support the idea that diabetics who make moderate drinking a routine are less likely to suffer from heart disease, despite fears it can throw off their bloodsugar balance. Researchers have already shown that having an occasional drink with dinner is good for the general population; it cuts the risk of heart disease and stroke by as much as 20 percent. In both new studies researchers found that diabetics who consumed more than half a drink per day cut their heart

disease risk in half compared with those who rarely drank or never consumed alcohol at all.

One protester, Leia Munster, blamed Nugent for the dispute. Munster said an activist tried to give Nugent a leaflet and Nugent spit on it.




