Fall Flight Index being dropped over accuracy, misuse problems

While duck hunting has been much-improved the last couple of seasons, it still hasn't equaled the salad days of the late 1960s and early 1970s fo some time, on the local scene or nation-wide. The Fall Flight Index issued by the U.S. Fish \& Wildlife Service for 2000 projected 90 million ducks, down 13 percent from a projection of 105 million in 1999
In spite of predictions for a record fall flight for the 1999-200 season, duck harvest dropped seven percent last year from the 1998-99 season, and duck harvest was $15,117,208$, down from the record level in 1998 of $16,360,528$.
U.S. duck hunters spent an average of nine days in the field last season and averaged harvesting 10 ducks for the season, down eight percent from the previous season.
The Delta Waterfowl Foundation, a non-profit organization that works toward a goal of a sustainable North American waterfowl population for the use and enjoyment of future generations, has long maintained that the Fall Flight Index prompts false hope among duck hunting enthusiasts who tend to believe the duck numbers are much higher than they actually are.
Evidently, Delta struck a nerve with the F\&WS. The Service has announced that it will be discontinuing the use of the current Fall Flight Index, admitting that its usefulness has been called into question.
Delta has pointed out, particularly in the past few seasons when duck numbers were thought to be high, but hunter success wasn't, that the Fall Flight Index is merely that--a comparison of one year to another, and not an estimate of actual duck numbers.


The usefulness of this number, Delta has maintained, is only in its measure of relative change.
Says Delta: "Don't look for 90 million ducks to darken the skies, they don't exist. If we look to the spring breeding number of 41.8 million, the result of an actual count, and apply a reasonable growth rate, it reflects that the fall flight of ducks in actual numbers is in the $50-60$ million range.
High hunter expectations from misuse of the Fall Flight Index are creating tension and causing loss of credibility of waterfowl management. Look to see fewer ducks this year than what you would have seen in 1999."
Delta urged the Fish \& Wildlife Service to come up with "a more biologically-based and reliable way to give duck hunters an idea of what to expect."
Lloyd Jones, vice president of Delta Waterfowl, says the Fall Flight Index was being "grossly misrepresented, even by some decision to abandon the Fall Flight Index as "a bold and
important move on behalf of duck hunters by committing to change the current forecast process."
According to Jones, there currently are not 105 million, or even 90 million ducks, and the Fall Flight Index "was misleading duck hunters, creating expectations that were unrealistic and eroding duck hunter confidence in waterfowl managers...and needed to be changed."
The Fish \& Wildlife Service is now working on alternatives to the Fall Flight Index. Among the possibilities is an annual production forecast.
Last season was certainly one of mixed results for local waterfowl hunters, who had some early chances at ducks and geese, but who were disappointed by the lack of waterfowl lat in the season, despite available water

Nation-wide, mallards were the top duck in the bag of sportsmen for the 1999-2000 season, with a take of just over 5.5 million. Mallards were followed in order by greenwing teal, gadwall, wood ducks, bluewing teal, widgeon, shovelers, pintail, and ringnecks.
For the 1999-2000 season the Canada goose harvest was down a bit from the previous year at just-under 1.9 million, which ranked it the fourth-highest harvest of Canada geese on record. Snow and blue goose harvest during the regular season wa 57,332 , the second-highest on record
The 1999 duck harvest ranked the fifth-highest since 1961.

## IRS changes tax code

Changes protect farmers, ranchers
DES MOINES, Iowa (AP) - The Internal Revenue
Service has agreed to a change in the tax code that will help protect farmers and ranchers from paying a higher
tax rate than other taxpayers, says Sen. Chuck Grassley, tax rate than other taxpayers, says Sen. Chuck Grassley,
R-Iowa.
The change appears in the new IRS Publication 225,
"Farmers Tax Guide," which says farmers and ranchers three-year period.

taxpayers who earn the same, but at a steady, consistent taxpaye
rate."

said. "It's not always easy, especially when the kids go home to less than Christian homes and have to make some hard

Many churches use special outreach programs, such as bus transportation, peanut butter and jelly get togethers,
youth hotlines, sporting events or even Main Street parties to reach youngsters.
Main Street 2000 , sponsored by the First United Methodist Church and joined by numerous others, attracted
more than 460 teens. The Church of the Nazarene's Hallelujah Night drews more than 700 kids and their parents. Other churches host ski trips, Christian athletic
tournaments and ministry work for teens. We have to get the kids involved in some kind of ministry Sometimes they use our programs as a basis for that "Events like these let us reach the kids, and ultimately the
entire family" Campel said "As youth ministers we don't really care where the kids are going, we just want them involved in a church, hearing the word and having a basis for
better choices."
Campbell and Haile both see the need for youth of all adolescents and teens, youth ministers will work to try get the kids in a group where they feel comfortable. Sometimes that

the least we can do is reach out to all the children and share with them our Hope," Haile said. "This is what all the churches are
trying to do when we build our kids churches, and our teen ministries."
Regardless of the denomination or beliefs, most churches now reach out to the community youth. "It's not about only way out of the worldly horrors," Haile said. "We reach the kids with what they can relate to. Sometimes it's a puppet
show. Sometimes it's high-tech electronics. Where ever the kids are at emotionally is where the teen ministries have to go to meet and catch them."

## Think Outside the box, but...

Recently, an old friend and business associate came by to see
my new office. While we were visiting he threw out this little my new office. While we were visiting he threw out this little
gem of wisdom. He said, "I know you've got to think outside but somebody has to stay in the box or it will blow away.".
Every year I work with business owners who becon amored with new ideas that they forget to take care of the customers who are paying the bills. Now, I believe in forward thinking, and certainly believe in thinking outside the box. However, if you forge
to guard your box it may blow away or a competitor may take it from
you.
Small-business owners seem to struggle with this concept. Some know they must change, but are reluctant to. Others spend so types are likely to go broke in today's environment.
When I think of resistance to change I remember a little story regarding former U.S. President Martin Van Buren. Seven years before he became president, Van Buren wrote a letter to then

are pulled at the enormous speed of 15 miles per hour by engines, which in addition to endangering life and limb of passengers, roar, and snort their way through the countryside. The Almighty certainly
never intended that people should travel at such breakneck speed. never intended that people should travel at such breakneck speed."
Ah, Mr. President, if you could only see us now. Hurtlin Ah, Mr. President, if you could only see us now. Hurtling
through space at the speed of sound. Yes, the times are still changing. Change is positive
Change is positive, but needs balance to succeed. We can still stand in our box while we're thinking outside it.

The best possible attitude you can take toward change is to embrace it. Don't try to resist change, because you can no more stop it than you can hold back a river by standing in it. The water will pass you by. So it is with change. You may advarice your business by
learning to swim with the current. Use change to get ahead,
accomplish more and travel faster.

By Jaqueline Cutler oTVData Features Syndicate Sometimes the familiar stories are the most difficult to tell. After all, everyone knows the ending, and comparisons are unavoidable. Yet if the story is compelling enough, a retelling is inevitable.
Thankfully, The Miracle Worker, airing on Sunday, Nov. 12, on ABC, lives up to its legacy. It is the story of Helen Ketler, who became blind and deaf when she was 18 months old. Her frustrations and outbursts ruled her genteel Southern family until a teacher changed everything. Annie ply grunt, eat from everyone's plate with her fingers, and pitch tantrums when she didn't get her way. The themes of a mother refusing to give up on her daughter, a teacher's unwillingness to lower her standards and a little girl trapped in a world where she can't communicate certainly withstand time.
Hallie Kate Eisenberg, best known as the curly-haired girl in the Pepsi commercials, plays Keller in the ABC version. Alison Elliott (The Spitfire Grill) co-stars as the indefatigable Sullivan, and David Strathairn (L.A. Confidential) portrays Keller's desperate father.
Elliott does a masterful job, starting with Sullivan's accent. "I wanted it to
be reflective of who Annie Sullivan actually is," Elliott says. "Her parents were Irish, and she grew up in the sys tem of poor, rural Massachusetts. ... I was told by several dialect coaches I was creating more work for myself but I really wanted to do it." Elliott unearthed the only known recording of Sullivan's voice and read every book she could find. She and Eisenberg also learned the manual al Khabet, which Sullivan used to teach palm.
Elliott hadn't seen the 1962 version when she was approached about the project, and she asked the executives, "Why don't you just get the rights and reshow the original?" After viewing it, however, she took the part. "Because this was so dear to so many people's hearts, I did pay homage to it. Of course, in watching it, I became tremendously envious that they had the years to do the stage."
Still, she and Eisenberg are quite natural together. In one very physical scene, Elliott accidentally hit Eisenberg under the eye, and a welt rose as the scene continued. Eisenberg never broke character.
Before this movie, Eisenberg says all she knew about Keller was a quotation: "The best and the most beautiful cannot be seen and touched. They must be felt with the heart." Once landing the role, she read many books, watched videos and observed schools for disabled children. "I saw children my age and how they act, and that's where I got all the noises and where to put my hands and everything."
If viewers are to glean a message from the movie, the 8 -year-old says, it come in life."
