Before you start canning the summer's best fruits and vegetables,
check your equipment to make sure it's in top-notch shape. Look over these points:
BOILING WATER BATH
Any metal cooking utensil that is deep enough to hold pint or quart canning jars set on a rack, plus 1 to 2
inches of boiling water above the jar tops, will serve as a boiling water bath
canner.
-Do use a rack; jars must not stand directly on the botiom of the pan. fitting lid.

- Ketules specifically designed for processing are available. STEAM PRESSURE CANNER The pressure canner is a heavy,
seamless ketle with a rack and locking lid with seal, pressure lock and safety valve. Do not use a pressure saucepan or canning.
