## VOTE FOR <br> AMENDMENT Number 3

ELECTION DAY, MOV. 5th
This is the last Amendment listed on the OFFICIAL BALLOT, a brief of which is shown here:

The Amendment to the Constitution of the State of Texas providing that subject to legislative appropriation, allocation and direction all net revenues derived from taxes, except gross production and ad valorem taxes, hall be used for the sole purposes of aequiring rights-of-way for and constructing and maintaining public roadways; for the administration of laws pertaining to traffic and safety; $;$ and for the payment of principa

revenue from the motor fuel tax shall be allocated to the Available Schoo Fund; providing and insuring that each county shall never derive less Fund; providing and insuring fates than the maximum amounts and per centages of such fees allowed to be retained by each county under the laws in effect on January 1, 1945; and negativing any interpretation of this amendment as authorizing the pledging of the state's creait for any pur.

Governor, Beauford H. Jest mission. It also has the whole hearted support of your local county and school officials.
