## Saddam faces stiffest test yet

Associated Press Writer NICOSIA, Cyprus (AP)-Saddam Hussein, who has tried to make Iraq
a regional superpower and himself leader of the Arabss, is facing his most dangerous challenge afier 22 years of
rule.
He has batted intermal foes, dueled
with Israel and warred against his larger neighbor Iran. But he has never confronted an opposition like the
U.S.-led coalition of Western and U.S.-led coalition of Western and
Arab forces arrayed against raq Arab forces arrayed against Iraq
because of its military occupation of
Saddam, object of one of the world's most intense personality
cults, has been effective ruler of lraq since 1968. He has been president
since 1979. since 1979 .
He set up a ruthless dictatorship stable government to a coup-plagu country, a nation created after World War I with a diverse population of
Shiite and Sunni Moslems, Christians and Kurds.
But his foreign adventures - the 1980-88 war with Iran, triggered by an Iraqi invasion, and the Aug. 2 blitzkrieg into oil-rich Kuwait
brought a halt to economic developbrough

strict economic sanctions, including strict economic sanctions, including
a total embargo on purchases of Iraqi oil, that wrecked the already war-weakened economy.
The war with Iran allowe
The war with Iran allowed Saddam oo build one of the world's major 1 million men under arms, 5,500 tanks, about 700 combat aircraft and hefty supply of chemical weapons. takeover, clearly the start of a bid to become paramount chief of the Arab world with a guiding hand on much of the world's oil reserves. daily broadcasts, poems and even children's nursery rhymes praising the "Knight of the ArabNatitin." His face is on posters at the entrance to
every village and on the frontpage of every newspaper. Saddam is president, chairman of

ary Command Council, and leader of the ruling Baath Socialist Party.

Higher postage
The cost of postage will most certainly go up next month. The Posta Rate Commission has tentatively approved a 29 -cent first class stamp.
up from the present 25 cents. The Poostal Service had asked for a 30 -cen stamp and may yet get it because the cut of a penny seems to be more trouble than it is worth.
Why do we need to pay more to mail our letters?
The increasedrevenue will go to pay higher salaries and betuer benefits percent more than the average American worker, yet they feel that they are not making enough to keep up with the times.
Cerlainly the Post Office in Perryton has the highest wage scale by far in this community. A beginning wage of $\$ 11$ an hour for new postal
clerks and carriers is far beyond what most business firms in thiscommunity can offer. This beginning wage is much higher than that earned by most veteran employees in other lines of work.
Yet the American Postal Workers Union and the National Association of Letter Carriers, in their negotiations with the U.S. Postal Service, want
a 22 percent pay increase over the next three years, unlimited protection against inflation, a 35 -hour work week and an additional paid holiday beyone the 10 now enjoyed.
The APWU and NALC represent more than 90 percent of the postal
service's 660,000 unionized a contract since Nov, 20. The Postal Service pays out 83 percent of its income to employees. Most of the new increase will go for salaries. But the general public mploy be excused for wondering why this group
inflation. into a separate govermment corporation some years ago and taken out of political patronage, but the unions still remained in control. The Postal Service has a publicly protected monopoly over the mail and is able to

The beginning of the school term is a convenient time to consider a child's allowance. If parents have not
been giving an allowance, it may be been giving an allowance, it may be
time to begin. If a child already receives an allowance, the amount may need to be adjusted for increas-
ing needs. ing needs. approaches in providing money for approaches in providing money for
children and teenagers: The "handout system" considered by many to be the least expensive; and the "allowance
system." Some parents feel they system. Some parents feet they
cannot afford to give their children a regular allowance because of other
financial obligations. However, when financial obligations. However, when
they take time to add up all the money they take time to add up all the money
that is "doled out" during a week, that is "doled out" during a week,
they are shocked at the total amount. Very often the amount of money that
is given "as needed" exceeds that of is given "as needed" exceeds that of a reasonable allowance.
Money provided in the "as needed"
system eliminates the opportunity for a child to learn to plan expenses, allocate funds, and set aside money
for use on another day. A valuable for use on another day. A valuable start by simply giving a child one week's lunch money and permitting him or her to take from the total each day to purchase a school lunch
Obviously, the expense to the family is no greater than if the money is "handed out" on a daily basis. But the child is introduced to handling money
and making it last to meet needs. and making it last to meet needs.
Children learn responsibility by assuming responsibility. When children are old enough to tell the difference between coins and when they begin to ask for money of their
own, that is the time to begin a own, tat is the time to begin a
regular allowance. Most children will be able to handle an allowancece by age
five or six, or even earlier if they five or six, or even earlier if they
have older brothers and sisters already receiving an allowance.

How much allowance is the right amount? Hold a farily y conference. Communication skills about money
can be learned while the decisions are fairly simple. In assessing the fairly simple. In assessing the
situation, keep in mind factors such as the child's age, family size and income, location of residence, like and dislikes and family routino. A general rule of thumb is to make a child's basic needs plus some extra" topermit opportunity to save or spend, yet small enough to force develop decision-making skills and an allowance provides an opportunity for a child to build these skills. Also, an allowance puts the burden of a
decision on the child, relieving
parents of having to evaluate every request for money or having to be th one to say "no" to purchase.
Probably the most effective way oo determine the amount of an allowance is to work out with the child how much he or she actually needs for school or other expenses, and how much he or she wi

## Tips can help home problems

problem? A.- Your first impulse may be to
try to paint over the stain, but many try to paint over the stain, but many

alone. Rust, grease or il, crayon wax alone. Rust, grease or oil, crayon wax

activated by the solvent (water or oil) in the paint, and bleed back through the new paint. This is true regardless of how many coats of paint you stain or remove the offending material from the wall before ainting.
The best approach is to try and your paint dealer for products your paint dealer for products
containing solvents that will remove splattered latex paints, grease,
crayons and other stains. Pour some crayons and other stains. Pour some and let the cleaner work for a couple of minutes. If you just try to scrub the stain away, you may also remove ome wall paint.
If the stain co
spot prime the stain area and then epaint the wall.
If the stain proves cmove, you can seal in almoult to stain with a shellac sealer. The shellac is fast-drying so it does not ctivate the stain material, but covers To avoid the shiny spots due to higher sheen over the shellac sealer,
seal the entire wall with shellac, not ust the stain.

Drama revolves around real-life Beirut hostages By Mary Ann Townsend
Marlo Thomas has been portrayin women with spunk ever since she starred as a single woman making it on her own in the big city on That Girl. In a drama airing Sunday, Jan. 13, on ABC, Thomas plays a socialite-turnedpolitical activist.
Thomas stars in one of the title roles in Held Hostage: The Sis and Jerry Levin Story, based on the real-life incident in 1984 when CNN correspondent Jerry Levin was taken hostage in Beirut, Lebanon. His wife. Lucille (Sis), fought a code of silence to see her husband freed after 11 months. It was the metamorphosis of this character that initially attracted Thomas to this role.

While Thomas was impressed with the change in Sis, the actress said she is even more inspired that the Levins continue efforts today to get hostages freed.
"She found her voice, and she is now very active in the peace movement she is getting her doctorate in peace studies; she teaches. I was impressed with that kind of change that she went through, and that she didn't just get her husband out and say, 'Well, that's that. I've got mine, to heck with everybody else.".
