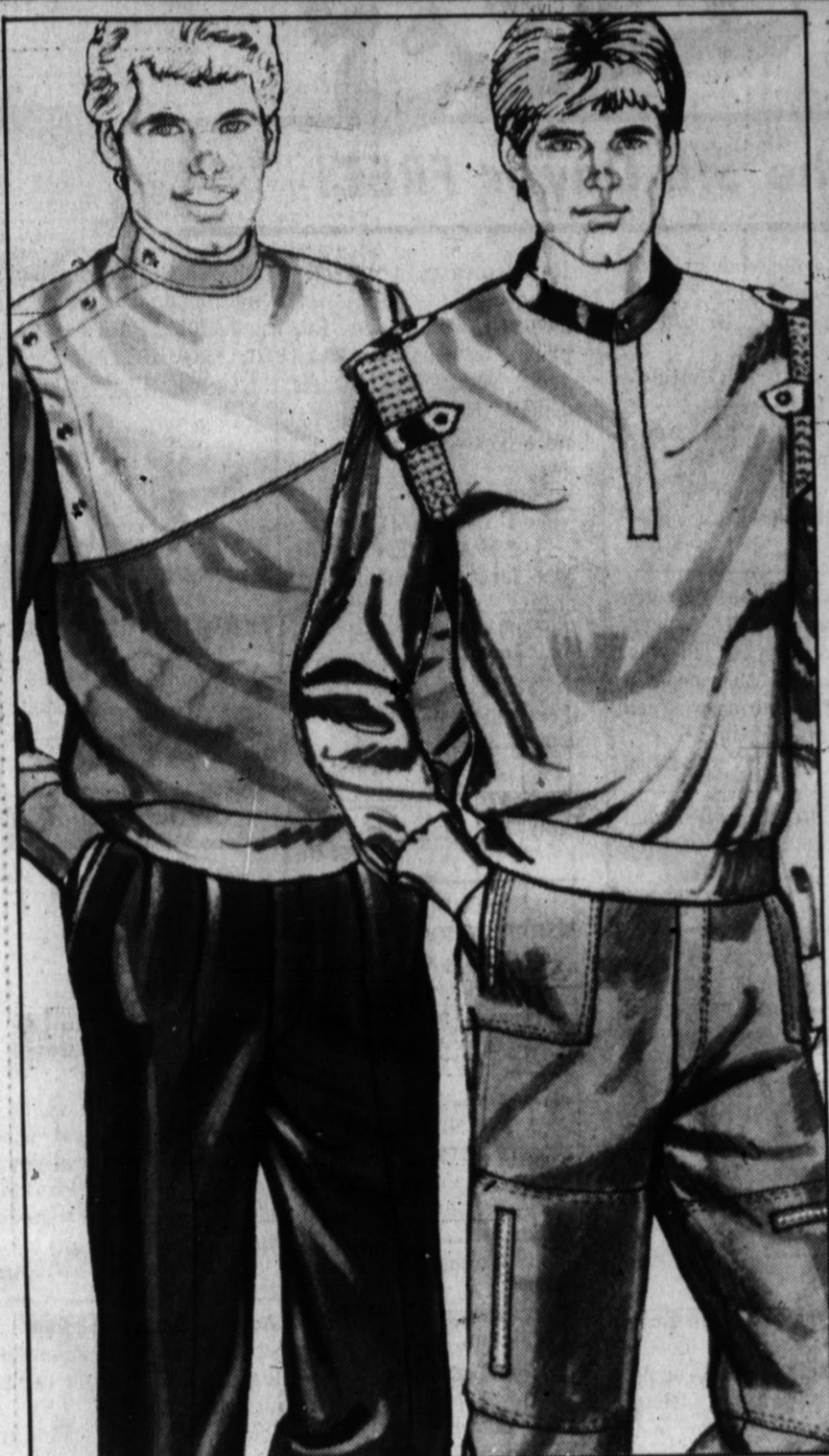

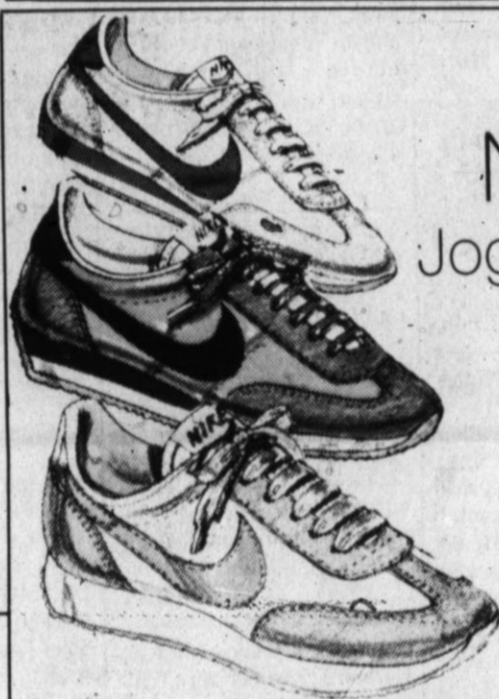

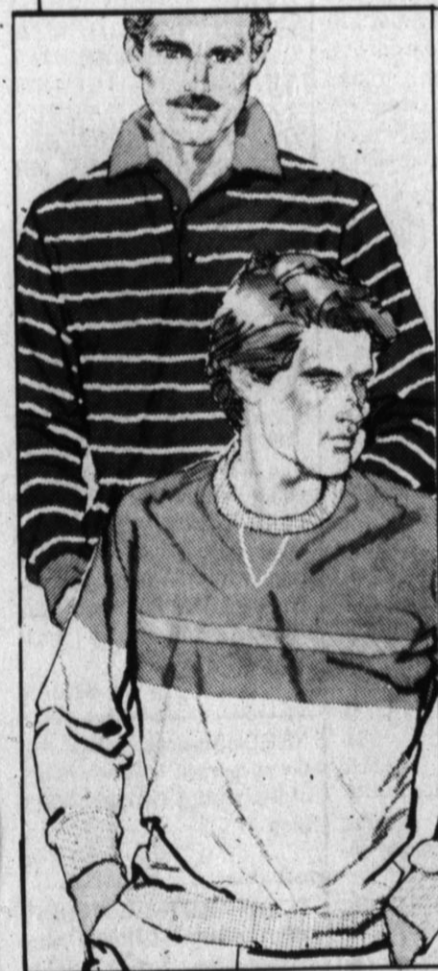

East Texas herb farm a family operation

GILMER, Texas (AP) — In the last few years as people seem to have become more appreciative of the past, their nostalgic interest in continental foods, gardening, ecology and crafts has sparked a revival in the growth and use of herbs. Although herbs have been around as long as mankind many people are unaware of their many uses, says Dan Wilson of Gilmer, who with other members of his family, runs an herb farm.

Each member adds a special area of expertise to the family venture, Wilson said. His mother's primary interest is in the use of herbs, while his grandmother has an almost magical touch when it comes to propagating plants. Tim and Cornelia, both of whom also have other jobs, are the jacks-of-all-trades on the farm. "When we first started, we started with every kind of herb you ever saw and some more," Wilson said. "However, some herbs wouldn't sell — there's not a big demand for catnip," he said. So the group cut their inventory back to include only herbs used in cooking, herbs used to make poultices and sachets, medicinal herbs and a few more that transcend all categories.

Shelves filled with such familiar greenery as parsley, oregano, chives and thyme are mixed with the more extraordinary plants such as the licorice-flavored anise marigold, white-spiked hyssop, spicy fennel and the purplish-white-flowered pineapple mint. To those unfamiliar with herbs, the plants and their uses may seem a confusing maze. But it's all really very simple, according to Mrs. Lindsay. "Herbs don't take a great deal of care," she said. "You don't need a green thumb." Anyplace, no matter how small, will do — including a hanging pot in the kitchen window or a small plot outside the kitchen door.

From that meeting, and Dan's desire to go into some type of agricultural business following his graduation, came the idea for the family farm. Mrs. Brannam says it's ground floor time for this business. "Mrs. Lindsay said, 'but I think it's in the basement.'" She said growing herbs, whether for one's own use or for resale commercially, is not an expensive venture. "You could start commercially with several hundred dollars like we did," she said. Or a \$20-\$25 investment in plants would be more than enough to start a private garden.

Currently the association has 50-100 members from all areas of the state. As research into the commercial growth and use of herbs continues at Texas Tech University, Mrs. Lindsay said she expected the industry to prosper and grow in the state. Right now, however, she and her son agreed that educating the public in the use of herbs is important. When customers visit the farm, both will take as much time as necessary to explain not only how to care for a plant but how to use it as well as providing several handouts filled with recipes and other information.

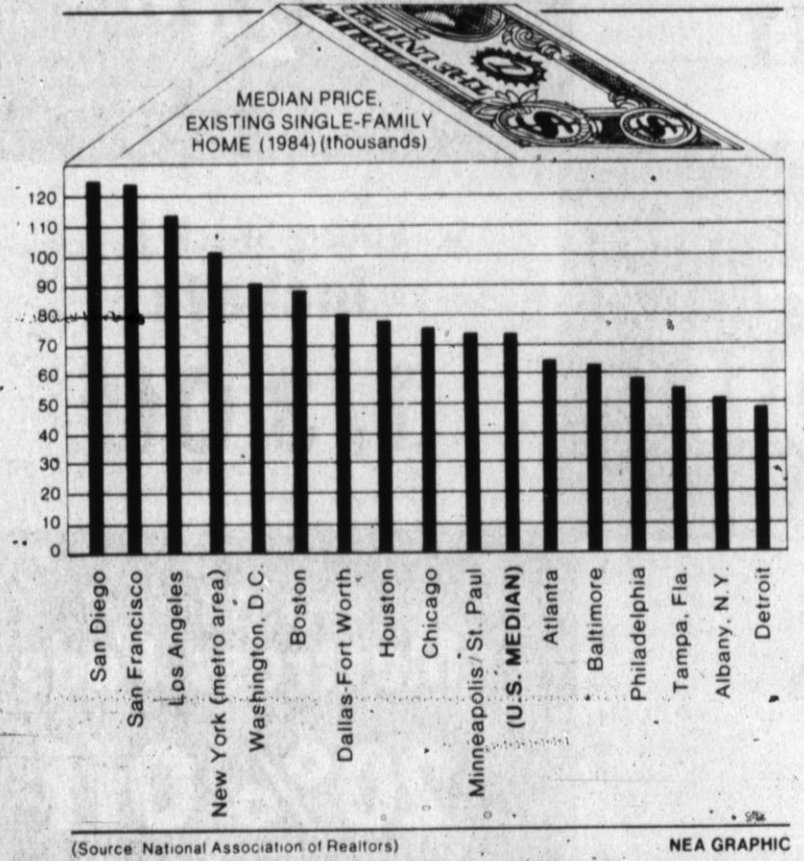

Boom brings more deaths

AUSTIN (AP) — Austin's total traffic deaths could top 100 this year for the first time, city police predict. "I'm guessing 106 if it continues like it did for the last six months," said police Sgt. Ernest Becker. As Austin's population continued to boom in 1984, traffic deaths also soared. The final count for the year was 87, up from the 53 recorded in 1983. Becker based his 1985 projection on a rate of just over two deaths per week. That would be a drop from recent months. There were 15 deaths in November — a pace of one every other day. There were 14 fatalities during December. "It's always difficult to tell about fatalities, but a year ago no one would have believed we would end up with this many," said Capt. Royal Wilson, who took over the police department's traffic division a year ago.

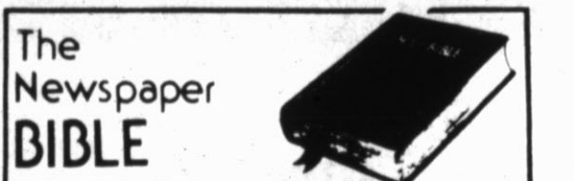
Whooper strays from course

AUSTIN (AP) — A young whooping crane has gotten off the beaten path and the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department wants the word out not to shoot at this member of an endangered species. The whooper was seen 15 miles south of El Campo in Wharton Wednesday. At last count, 83 of the whoopers had been spotted at their winter grounds, the Aransas National Wildlife Refuge on the Texas coast. "Several birds aren't in for sure, and it is not known whether there were losses in migration," Bruce Thompson of the department's wildlife division said Wednesday. Jim Cox, a department spokesman, said the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service had confirmed that the crane is a juvenile, which means it left the nest this past spring.

Toxic waste believed to be added hazard on pitted road

MOSS BLUFF, Texas (AP) — For more than a decade, four-wheel-drive vehicles and high-top rubber boots have been a necessity for residents along Frontier Park Road in Liberty County. But now there is the threat of an additional hazard — toxic contamination from oily sludge that was sprayed on the road 15 years ago to reduce dust. Tests have shown the oil is contaminated with hazardous wastes, officials say. In addition, Texas Department of Water Resources officials say industrial wastes have been dumped in pits near the road. "I've spent \$200 advertising in the last year, trying to rent my four-bedroom frame house," said William Cornell, 59. "But when I have to take people down there on my tractor to see it, they're not interested." Residents say ambulances have refused to venture over the deeply rutted tracks that mark the road. Four-wheel-drive vehicles and rubber boots are standard equipment for the three families who still live there.

McGee said he did not point out the oily pits to prospective buyers at the time, but contends the dumps were visible from the road. "We didn't know it could be dangerous," says resident Liz Taylor. "For six years, we had a trailer parked next to one pit which is on our right of way." Mrs. Taylor said her husband tried to grade one area, but his bulldozer kept slipping into "that yucky mess."

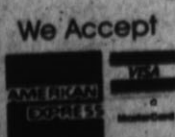
