### Christmas Eve In No Man's Land

(Editor's Note: This beautiful story was repeated a number of times by Veterans after World War I. It was probably told publicly for the first time by Alexander Woolcott at a meeting of the National Conference of Christians and Jews.

Christ remain with all mankind, every day, so that all the horrible deeds of violence could be blotted out for all time!)

It was Christmas Eve during World War I. Two hostile regiments faced each other

across the trenches. No activity was scheduled for that evening, and two warring troops were celebrating Christmas in the freezing cold and slimy mud.

From the Allied trenches came the sound of singing and laughing as packages from home were opened and letters read from loved ones

far away. From the German, too, came sounds of revelry and - who knows - perhaps they too were reading letters from their wives and children. After a while, as the damp cold penetrated their bones, both sides became quiet.

Suddenly from one trench came a light tenor voice

singing in English, "Silent Night, Holy Night, All is calm, all is bright -" Other voices joined in one by one. Then - from the listening German - came a chorus,

"Stille Nacht, Heilige Nacht -"

In a moment enemies of the day were singing together in the night.

Soon a head popped over the Allied embankment. "Merry Christmas, Fritz," called a voice.

"Froeliche Weihnachten!" Roared a chorus. A man climbed over the German trench, hand extended.

"Froeliche Weihnachten!" He shouted.

In another moment No Man's Land was filled with soldiers, German and Allied, shaking one another's hands, wishing one another a Merry Christmas, each in his own language, exchanging tobacco and candy.

For the rest of that Eve, there was a Christmas party in No Man's Land. Men who were to kill one another the next day sang together and shared with each other the little that they had. On that Eve men of good will walked between the trenches, and with them walked the spirit that is Christmas.

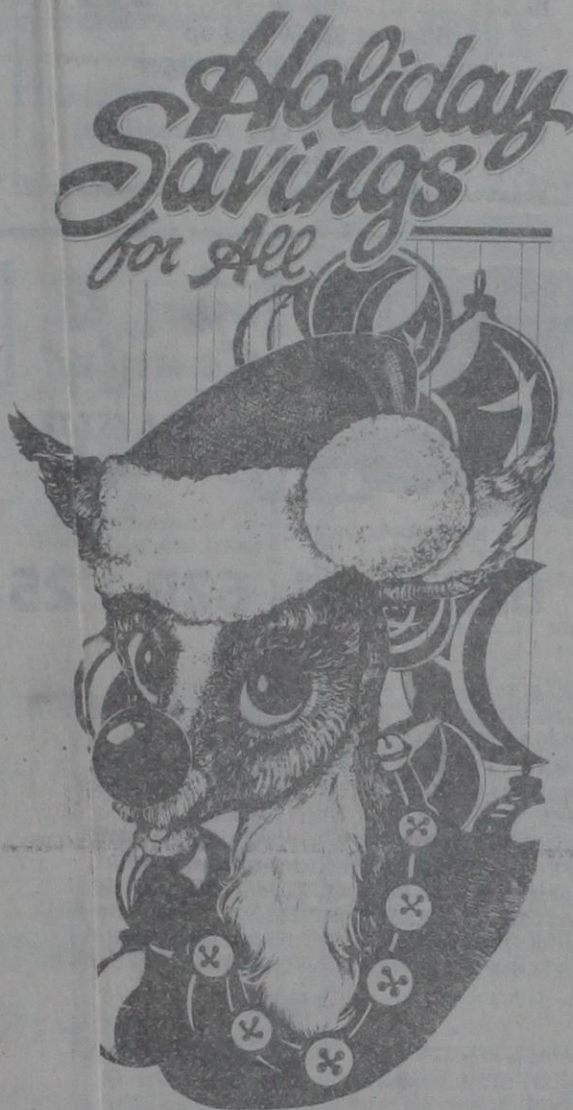

## Most Condos Charge Monthly Ownership Fee

Most condominium associations require owners to pay a fee, which may vary from \$10 to more than \$100 per month.

This money is used by the condominium association to meet its responsibilities for development, management and upkeep of the common areas. These include everything in the condominium except the interior space of the units. The association must spend funds for cleaning, lawn care, utilities, repairs, taxes and insurance.

There also may be special recreational and social facilities to maintain, such

as a pool or club house. In addition, the association may employ a professional manager to oversee these duties.

Monthly assessments are often the only source of funds to pay for all these services. For special purposes, such as a major repair, an additional assessment may be necessary.

### HEAT PUMPS COST MORE BUT LESS

If you are using electricity to heat your house, here is a tip that might save you some money. A heat pump produces far more heat for each kilowatt-hour of electricity

than does a resistance heater.

This means your electric bill could go down substantially while you maintain your present level of comfort. A heat pump operates somewhat like an air conditioner in reverse, and, in fact, can actually warm your house in winter and cool it in summer.

The reliability of heat pumps have often been questioned, but present heat pump designs appear to be as reliable as conventional electrical heating units. A heat pump costs more than a conventional electrical heating unit, but it could be worth the added cost in areas where electricity, propane or butane are used for heating.

### RESALE FINANCE PROGRAM OFFERS CHEAPER MORTGAGES

Today's homebuyers are finding it difficult to locate affordable financing, but a new Federal National Mortgage Association program may offer one solution. It is called the resale finance program.

If the mortgage association owns the existing mortgage on a home, a credit-worthy buyer can arrange a new mortgage at a rate well below the market. The new resale finance mortgage reflects the property's current market value. There can be as little as 5 percent down payment.

Regardless of the old loan, the new one will always be a conventional, long-term and carry a fixed, individually

tailored interest rate. The new rate will be based on the interest rate, unpaid balance, and other features of the old loan and the amount and term of the new loan.

### LIFE-CARE COMMUNITIES PROVIDE COMFORT, INDEPENDENCE

Ten percent of the citizens of Texas are 65 or older. Predictions for the year 2020 show an increase to 13 percent.

Older Texans want to retain their own lifestyles and independence from families. Because of this, the life-care community, a popular but financially troubled concept of the 1970's, is once again being promoted.

Life-care communities may have cottages or apartments for those who require no assistance; a complex providing limited medical service; and a nursing home equipped for extensive medical dependence. Residents are encouraged to be as independent as their physical conditions allow.

The Texas Department of Health requires one or more licenses for life-care development and operation, as well as a certificate of need.

### INSTALLMENT SALE CAN SOFTEN TAX BITE

If you are going to sell real estate, here is some advice that might reduce the tax bite on any profit you make.

A revision in federal tax law allows a person who sells real estate to receive any part of the purchase price at

any time. The tax-saving feature of this installment sales provision is that you only pay tax on money that you have received.

This could keep you in a lower tax bracket and reduce your overall taxes. For instance, if you receive payments in December and January you could spread your taxes over a two-year period, while receiving the

full amount of the sale in two or three days.

An installment sale can also be structured to have most the purchase price due in retirement years, when your income and tax bracket are lower. Discuss the installment sale provision with your accountant or tax adviser before selling real estate.

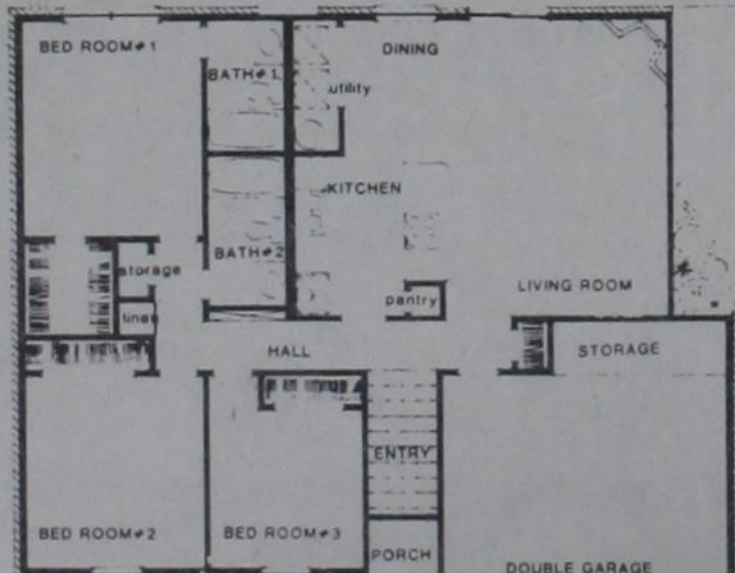

## M.M. White & Associates Plan 2,000 Foot Wildcat

A 2,000-foot wildcat for oil is planned by M.M. White & Associates of Eastland at a drillsite nine miles southwest of Cisco, Eastland County. The location is in a 120-acre lease in the H&TC RR Co. Survey, Sec. 80, Blk. 3. Well's designation is the No. 2 Hagan.

TLC Development Corp. of Ft. Worth has filed for permit to drill the No. 2 and No. 3 H.G. Beene, two projected 1,850-foot wildcats for oil or gas, two miles south of Scranton. The ventures will be in a 20-acre lease in Eastland County's H&TC RR Co. Survey, Sec. 127, Blk. 3.

A wildcat for oil is scheduled for spudding two miles southeast of Throckmorton by Sierra Exploration Co., operator from San Antonio. The well will be known as the No. 1 Bert Davis, with projected total depth of 4,990 feet. It will be situated in a 203 acre lease in Eastland County's S.F. Shaw Survey, A-251.

Location has been staked by Hemispheric Oil & Gas Inc. of Carrollton for a 1,000-foot Eastland County wildcat. The explorer well will be known as the No. 2 Erma Lowe. It is in a 40-acre lease in the Louisa Pamplin Survey, two miles south of

Three wildcats for oil are scheduled for spudding 10 miles south of Cisco by Dallas Energy Development Corp., operator of Dallas. The three wells each have a projected total depth of 4,000 feet. The No. 1 Chambliss will be situated in an 80-acre lease in Eastland County's H&TC RR Co. Survey, Sec. 77. The No. 2 and 3 St. Johns are to be in a 191-acre lease in the Mary Ann Clark Survey, Lot 4.

A 3,999-foot wildcat is planned by Leshe Oil & Gas Inc. of Columbus, Ohio, at a drillsite four miles southwest of Romney, Eastland County. The loca-

tion is in a 135-acre lease in the Mary Ann Clark Survey, Lot 2. Well's designation is the No. 5 J.B. Hunt "B".

The Davenport Field gained a new gas producer when the No. 1 Big Mike "A" was completed by Comanche Investments of Cisco, three miles east of Ranger.

On a 2-inch choke, the well showed ability to yield up to 390,000 CF gas per day. The absolute open flow came in at 2,000,000 CFD. Location is in a 20-acre lease in Eastland County's Andrew Bradley Survey, A-15.

Comanche took the hole to 3,576 foot bottom and perforated for production 3,367 to 3,389 feet into the wellbore.
