| Because the stakes are high, a person's life, his good name his liberty, or his property, courtrooms are sometimes superenarged with drama ano and anger. <br> Despite the excitement, the judge has to be impartial and open-minded as to issues, evi dence, parties, witnesses, and dence, parties, witnesses, and lawyers. To fail in this may cause a case to be tried again or reversed on appeal. <br> This makes a judge's job a hard one. For he must first keep order so that the facts go to the jury in a way to lead to sound, unprejudiced verdicts. The judge must also instruct the jury on the law, and decide what telitimoly goes into evidence. <br> Meantime lawyers on both sides are duty bound to work with skill and vigor to protect their clients and to advance their cause. <br> In this tense atmospherte some people break over the line and do things which may be termed "foul play" or show disrespect for the court.
