In addition, the maximum rate of three percent that can be paid on bonds, which is prescribed by law, is a limiting factor. <br> "We" are processing a few loans as money becomes available from the revolving fund created by bonds sold during the first progrm. We are also watching the money market very carefully and exploring every possibility of sale. The bonds will be offered again just as soon as we feel there is a possibility of selling them," he said.
