

Enter \$67,000,000 in Bonds on Books Dallas.—The bookkeeping and cler leal force of 43 men at the federal reserve bank was busy all day Sunday opening mail and entering Liberty bond subscriptions on the books. # U. S. TROOPS IN TRENCHES TEXAS NEWS BRIEFS

The Graham public school building was destroyed by fire, with a loss of \$14,000.

Refunds for unused wholesale and retail liquor and malt dealers licenses as a result of Dallas going dry amounted to \$19,949.88. The city appropriated this sum from the \$35,641 recently paid to the city by the power and light company as a tax on poles and wires.

The Midlothian gin at Venus was destroyed by fire together with a carload of cotton seed and 40 bales of cotton. The sin was valued at about \$16,000 and was insured. The cotton and cotton seed burned was valued at \$31,000, making a total loss of about \$47,000.
