Washington—The joint conferces on the war revenue bill completed their draft after two weeks of eliberation.

### GARFIELD FIXES COAL PRICES

Fuel Administrator Announces Final Decision, Which Will Be Bind-ing on All Dealers.

Decision, Which Will Be Binding on All Dealers.

Washington.—Fuel Administrator Garfield announced regulations, effective at once, for the limitation of the retail prices of bituminous and anthractic coal throughout the country.

In the conclusions arrived at, not the specific price which the retail dealer will be allowed to charge the consumer, but the gross margin which the retail dealer will be allowed to added to the average wholesale cost of his coal in making retail prices.

The retail dealer will be allowed to sell coal to the consumer at a price representing an advance of not more than 30 per cent over the retail gross margin of 1915.
