From rumors that are flying thick and fast, and information from a reliable source, it is likely that within the next ninety days a wildcat oil well will be drilled in the immediate vicinity of Ropesville.

It is stated that land has been leased that lies within a mile of town by a major company and that the contract calls for a well in three months.

One well, about ten miles west of Ropes, has been plugged and written off as a dry hole.

However, it has been the contention of geologists during past years that there was a large pool of oil in the immediate vicinity of Ropes. In fact, there are producing wells within five and six miles of town, and it is thought that a thorough exploration of the country in the immediate vicinity of Ropes that one of the largest fields in this county will be uncovered.

While we have great wealth in agriculture, we could also stand more wealth in oil, so this new development will be watched with interest.
