## Helpful Hints:

A blender works best when given
sinall quantities, but should the blending action cease to draw the mixture down into the blades stop
the motor and stir the mixture the motor and stir the mixture
with a rubber spatyla from the sides into the center. In this way, air will be introdiced and the blending action will continue. If the mixture is too thick, you may
need to add a little more liguid need to add a little more liquid.
Vegetables should be cut chunks before adding to the blender; an apple in eighths or more;
carrots into half-inch pieces (quarcarrots into half-inch pieces (quar-
tered or halved if very thick). tered or halved if very thick).
Chop only one or two cups of Chop only one or two cups of
vegetables in the blender at one time.
