#### 30-Day Residents Eligible To Vote

The following was sent in by Raymond O. Dennis, County Clerk:

The decision of the United States Supreme Court in *Dunn v. Blumstein* has invalidated state laws which require more than 30 days residency in the state or locality in order to be eligible to vote.

The Texas law has now been enjoined by a federal court in the case of *Whatley v. Bullock* which was decided on March 31, 1972.

Persons who have resided in the state and locality for 30 days and have been registered for 30 days prior to the election in which they wish to vote are now eligible to vote in state and local elections. Persons entering the state may register to vote immediately upon their arrival.

The cutoff deadline for registration for those who wished to vote in the May 6 Primary Election closed April 5, 1972.

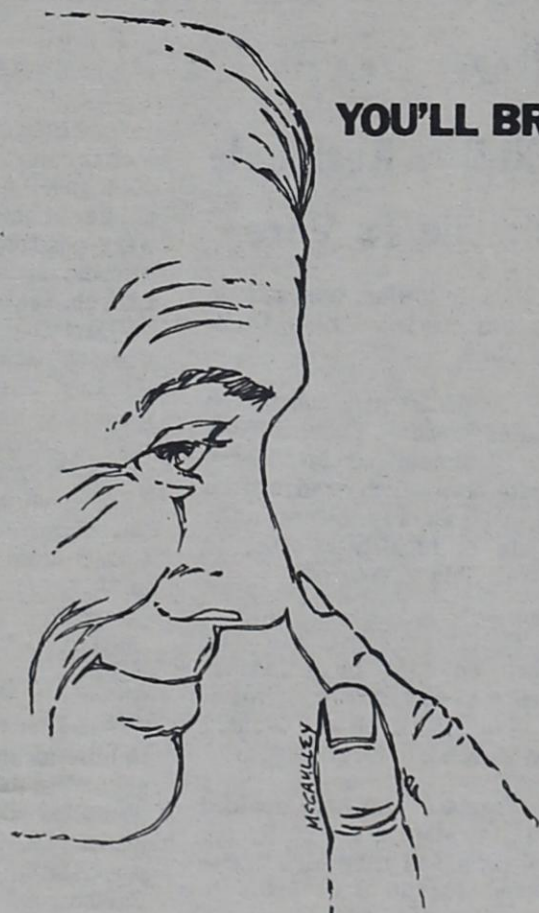

**Polynesian Lamb Chops**  
4 to 5 lamb arm or blade chops, cut 3/4 to 1 inch thick

- 1/2 cup salad oil
- 1/2 cup soy sauce
- 1/4 cup lemon juice

Combine salad oil, soy sauce and lemon juice. Place chops in a shallow dish. Pour marinade over chops and marinate for 2 hours, turning occasionally. Place chops on broiler rack and insert broiler pan and rack so the top of the meat is 3 inches from the heat. Broil until browned, 6 to 8 minutes. Turn, brush with marinade and broil second side until browned and chops are done, 4 to 5 minutes. 4 to 5 servings.
