IN LOOKING BACK over the fiscal developments of 1962 we find one bright spot in the tax picture this was the first year in 17 years in which there were no increases in state gasoline taxes in all the United States!

We naively hope this situation continues, for aft er all, $\$ 6$ billion a year is the price added to the cost of driving because of the gasoline taxes. Authorities reveal that on the average, these taxes amount per cent of the basic price of the fuel itself.

Gasoline no longer is a luxury, but a necessity and it looks to this editor
