and are to run thirty years, except that the Government reserves the right to pay them

Government fifteen years from date, the bonds will run the full thirty years.

the rate of $3 t$ per cent per annum, and the interest is payable semi-annually on the fif-
teenth day of December and the fifteenth day of June in each
