county. Over 5,000 bushels of registered and certified Westar wheat were purchased for planting this year, plus 10,000 bushels 1,00 bushels of certified Coman-
che. These varieties are recommended as good millers. The grain was purchased from elevat ors and feed companies that ar
cooperating by stocking good planting seed.
