High Speed Chase Ends With Gray County Deputies Shooting Out Tires

Gray County deputies and area DPS officers were forced to shoot out the tires of a stolen vehicle during a high speed chase.

The chase began just after 9:30 a.m. when a Georgetown man, James Andrew, Dornwell, driving a 2003 Chevrolet pickup stole gas from a Shamrock station. Deputies attempted to stop Dornwell, but he fled the scene.

When the chase moved onto Interstate 40, deputies were joined by Department of Public Safety officers and

high speeds and quickly became very dangerous. As the chase neared McLean, deputies made the decision to shoot out the tires after attempt to put out stop strips failed. When the pickup was stopped, Dornwell was taken into custody without currently being held for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and evading arrest in the Wheeler County Jail on \$4000 bond. Volunteers for the Groom Ambulance service are a scarce commodity these days. "We are down to one or two volunteers who can cover the area during the day," said volunteer Rick Prather. We are having to depend a lot on other area towns to cover Groom while most of our volunteers are at work."

While this is not the best situation for obvious reasons like distance and waiting time, it also leaves the town the ambulance comes from short-handed. According to ambulance volunteers, two EMT's are required to be in the ambulance for it to

transport a patient

High Speed Chase Ends With Gray County Deputies Shooting Out Tires

Gray County deputies and area DPS officers were forced to shoot out the tires of a stolen vehicle during a high speed chase.

The chase began just after 9:30 a.m. when a Georgetown man, James Andrew, Dornwell, driving a 2003 Chevrolet pickup stole gas from a Shamrock station. Deputies attempted to stop Dornwell, but he fled the scene.

When the chase moved onto Interstate 40, deputies were joined by Department of Public Safety officers and the pursuit reached very high speeds and quickly became very dangerous. As the chase neared McLean, deputies made the decision to shoot out the tires after attempt to put out stop strips failed. When the pickup was stopped, Dornwell was taken into custody without further incident. He is currently being held for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and evading arrest in the Wheeler County Jail on \$4000 bond. No officers were injured in the chase.
