

Covenant was awarded a \$5.000 grant for a radiant warmer bed for Covenant's NICU. Radiant warmers are beds that keep newborns warm and allow medical staff to control the infant's temperature. These beds are extremely important for the NICU. The purchase of the new warmer will allow the NICU to provide a warm, nutring nevironment to premature shies and micropreemies being treated at Covenant Women's and Children's. The radiant warmer will also help system to impact its "Perfect Care" goal. You can't say Mexican singer Ximena Sarifana didn't warn us. "Keep in mind far if mon a different world." she sings at the start of her finst Englishlanguage CD.

She's singing about the complexity of her character, one defined by a self-satirizing sophistication that's both earnest and hilaions. Small wonder Sarifana confuses people. In fact, Sarifana's disk offers one of the most inventive, and pleasing, reinventions of new wave pop in years, enlivened by a point of view that's cumingly addividual.
