True, migcaine headaches are "sickening", often debititatins pains that trirob anwachesshioleraly in sually affected more often han men. The sterotyped migraine personality is anxious,
erectionistic, and may be esentful and appea
atigued. The attacks las minutes or as long as a few days, and headaches may be separthed by weeks or precipitated by menstruation or intake of certain foods or by alcohol. The attacks are preceded by ertigo, facial flushing or he appearance of flashing ights. As the headache progresses, there is incroasing is crivabildiy. aussa and vomiting Migraine may be caused by excess vasodilation of the biood vessels outside the skull such as the maxillary dilation by iiself does not cause pain. The diagnosis can be contirmed by noting of digital pressure over the common caroted or externai carotid artsries, located on the side of the "Adams pple". This condition mus be differentiated from othe disorders which cause pain imilar to migraines. example trigeminal neralgia and myofacial pain dystunction. Migratine headaches are treated almeqt, antigely medically
