Most of us can look back over our lives and testify to the fact hat many of the unusual things which happened, whether good or bad, have been unexpected, Without prior warning the unexare corners that we turn in our spiritual growth and develoopment.
A biblical event illustrating such an experience is Moses' unex pected meeting with God at the burning bush in the Midian desert (Exodus 3)
Moses had received no advance notices concerning what was about to happen in his life. He had gone from prince of Egypt to occupationsss. On this particulaptian to be the lowliest of all the Midian desert, at Mount Horeb, a place of extreme sollitude. Moses had been here before. Here in the loneliness of the place he had communed with himself, with nature, and with God Here Mosess had been under the special instruction of the hat grew at his feet and the llock of sheep that were around him browsing on the grass.
This day as Moses was tending his sheep, God used an instrument to manifest His presence that was an unique as the loaetion. A scrubby, old acacia bush, seared and blistered by the hot desert sun and winds, was errveloped by a strange fire, and was consumed. And the angel of the Lord appeared in the fire a spectacular experience that would occur in a "bush"? -. the small, the ordinary. Moses was about to embark on the most important mission of his life. Before he could represent God to the lebrew people, he had to receive a vision of the ineffable glory f God in his own soul.
All too often we miss God in our everyday lives because we vertook the bush that is full of mystery, containing a heaventy presence, a divine voice, that will make us unique for useful an ruifful service.
