## Two Sets of Rules

Five yearsago, Al Carnpanis, an official with the Los Angeles Didgers, (appeared on the television program "Nightine" and tried to explain the ubsence of blacks as managers and in the front offices of basebail teams. His comments, such as blacks not having the "necessities" for those jobs, were so obviously prejudiced they prompted an outcry.
Baseball was embarrassed. Many promises were made that an all-out effort would be made to improve the situation. I met with then Commis--sioner Peter Ueberroth, and he seemed genuinely interested in reform.
Have we progresed in five yeas?? Not really. Other thin a very vis. Have we progressed in five years? Not really. Other than a very vis-
ible action or two such as naming Bill White president of the National ible action or two, such as naming Bill white president of the National
League, nothing has happened. That is why when "Nightime" invited me to appear on the fith anniversary of its first baseball program, I made no bones about my feelings.
I know Commissioner Fay Vincent has a tough job. But I also know that somewhere along the line somebody's got to take the bull by the homs and say we've got to do something about this problem. Let's face it, there are two sets of rules for hiring in baseball. I see case anter case of wime players nird aigut off ne feld mo important baseball jobs. When blacks apply for these jobs, they are told they have
to have years of experience.
know of a sudy that baseball has carefully smothered that shows most blacks view baseball as a white man's sporn. This is a shocking statement to me, and it should be to the commissioner.
Baseball isn't doing enough to promete the game in black neighborhoods, Many black communities don't have Little League programs or Peewec Leagues. Many poorer schools are dropping baseball as an organized sport. Money also is a factor. It costs a great deal to put a glove on a kid's hand, a uniform on his back, a pair of spikes on his feci and to provide a playing fietd. In akdition, the average black family can't ar-
ford to come to the balipark as often as the average white family, Even if you buy tickets in the Bob Uecker seats, it costs a lot of money. Many giffed athletes who might have chosen baseball 30 years ago are now choosing football or basketball. They know that for every three or four coltege basebill sclioiarships there are 40 footbalt scholarships.
What can be done? Well, there's a small program now that pronotes the game of baseball in black neighborhoods. Professional baseball has given the program some operating money in recent months. But that program was created by a scout in the Texas Rangers organization, not by the commissioner's office.
Professional baseball's leadership needs to direct some of its creativity to this problem as well as open up its purse. Team owners also nzed
to reach beyond the same old-fashioned, "Good Old Boy" system and give some of the management jobs to retiring black players. hif Hank Aaron is the top home-run hitite of all hime with $7 \leqslant 5$ homers. A me
haseball's Hall of Fame, Hamk is serior vice president of hee Allanta Braves.
