Propositions 42 and 48 are basically about creating college cholarship athletes who are students fitss and athiles second．Propos tion 48 ，which his been in erisence for five years，states that students who do not meet certain academie standards when entering coilege－－
minimum SAT score of 790 －cannot participate in smorts during thein freshman year．They must spend that year proving they can do collepe－ level work．It they cun＇To the work，they never get the chance to play Proposition 42 （which became an NCAA nle Isst ycar）provides thi students whio don＇t meet those same academic suandards can never be offered scholarships to begin with．They will be excluded，
Some people have a problem with that．I don＇t．Think it puts the onu： back where it belengs－on the parents and on the high schools．Many high schools let star athetes slide through without ever cracking a book The parents nover question why their children don＇t do any schoolwot． These people need to learn that they are not heiping sudents，outy hur－ they don＇t have to，
Studens，and I do mean stheceus，who are poorly prepared for college are easity frusirued and often drop out．When they drop out，they lose oun on an opportunity to nake something of their lives．
It was a long time in coming，but Proposition 42 tinaily draws a tine．in fact．I＇d like to see the NCAA go even further and bring back freshman ineligibility．Freshman ineliegibility gives stadent athiletes a chance to ad－ i．： 10 being in college before thrusting thein ints the sporlight of NCAA spors．It＇s my feeling that very few freshmen can play on a high enough vel to be stinters anyway，so why force them along？
