## Understanding AIDS

AIDS in the Workptece
As the number of AIDS casas in America increases. questions will arise about possible exposure to the disease in the workplace. This article is designed to answer those questions. Initial concern about a deadiy itraid of a new ill ness untill hey underatand 1 he tacts You will tind that unilike many other illnessee, ADS is aproad willy in limited ways, and ther you are not at rith in the nly in limited ways, and that you are not at risk in the workplice

Areat deal is known about what causes AIDS, hov ADS is tranamitted from person to person, and how AIDS can be avoided. What is not yet known is how to cure the sease
AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome) is caused by a virus. This virus is called HIV. It the virus gets into a person's bloodstream, it can attack a certain kind of white blood cells that is vital to the working of the immune system. Over time, the infected person's immune system may be unable to fight off certain other "opportunistic diseases.
AIDS is difficult to gett The virus is not easily spread from person to person, and it is never spread by casual ontact
Medical authorities who have studied thousands of cases of AIDS for several years agree that AIDS is spread in only three ways:
a Sexual intercourse with a person infected with the virus. Semen can transmit the virus. Vaginal fluids can also transmit the virus. As in the case with other sexually transmitted diseases, the proper use of condoms prevents transmission.

* Sharing IV drug needie with an infected person. Sharing an IV drug needle with comeons else can inject the virus directly into thie users bioodstream.
- A woman infected with the AIDS virus who becomes pregnant or breastfeeds can pass the virus to the baby. The AIDS virus cannot be passed through the air Sneezing, breathing or coughing do not spread AIDS Touching, hugging, holding or shaking hands do nol spread AIDS.
No cases of AIDS have resulted from casual contact. No health care workers, such as doctors, nurses, dentis, or orderlies have contacted AIDS from routinely taking care of AIDS patients while using proper infection control measures. Even where children have played, eaten, slept, kissed, and fought with a brother or sister with AIDS, none have become infacted.
So long as people with AIDS feel well enough to work, they are able to work at no risk to theniselves, and at no risk to their co workers or to the public.
The companies having experienced in dealing with employpes with AIDS have determined that AIDS can be treated like any other life threatening illness, such as cancer. or heari disease. Thousands of persons who have been diagnosed with AIDS are successfully employeo. AIDS is spread through biood or sexual contact. No cases of AlDS have ever been inked to sharing typewhers, lelephones, lools, papers, water ountains, facitties. AIDS is not transmitted through preparation or

serving of tood or beverages. Food is not a vehicle for transmitting the AIDS virus. Contact with salive, tears or swcat is not at risk. No cases of AIDS have ever been linked to these fluids. Outside the body, the AIDS virus is

On the job. there is no need for any special protection. Off the job, don't share IV drug needles fif you use iV drugs, seek professional drug courseling), and uniest you know your sex paitner's sexual history, condoms should be used. Protect yourself from fear by learning the facts.
Remember, all your co workers need the saine kind of conoern and support that you would want it you had a serious and prob-bly fatal disease. Talk with your supervisor or manager, your company human relations or personnel department, and appropriate employee representatives to remain informed about AIDS, and to
keep you and your co workers informed. Also; fear of a new disease may not vanish overnight, even where there is no risk to you. Be patient with yoursell. Help end fear by learning and spreading the lacts about AIDS.

It appears that integration may have created a tremendous setback for a great deal of Blecks. Even those that may heve benefitted, they too lost sompthing that has always beon the root of being Black. in the years since integration, there appesis to br a lost of Black values and identity. A vast majority of Blacks seek White vaiues and can more readily identify with White America more so than Black values and Black America. The old you can't take the cr. intry out of the person" is no longer y truism. With integration we lost great deal of ionging Black traditions and values that were pstablished within the home and reenforced at school. With intugreilin the home and reenforced at school. With integration, Blacks at eariy ages interact with White America which is
reenforced by White America being portrayed on reenforced
With all the activities generated by various groups to honor Dr. Martin Luther King, well over half our Black youth under 12 know as little as three things about him. And one would be totally shocked at the large number of 18 and under that can not relate to the trials and tribulations endured by our fore parents. How many of our under 25 Blacks can accept and relate to hardships, sacrifices anc hostile treatment our fore parents endured just to put food on the table, or get a drink of water or the "reckless aye balling law" that was enforcible only against Blacks that looked too long at a White woman That it has only been during the past 25 years that we became recognized as Black People instead of Col/ored People. History and traditions are vital ingredients to one having a feeling of self worth. Black tradition does not look favorable upon unwed teenage pregnancy. Black tradition places a drug user lower than a snake's belly Black tradition allows for one key to be left under the door mat or flower pot as our morals forbidded taking someone elses property. Traditions and morals can be a tremendous motivator for people who have pride and a sense of responsibility for others, especially their own race. It was Black pride that coined the phrase "give a Elack did, he gave it his best shot Look what George Washington Carver did with the peanut and even better, Wasm the guts of an animal the Black temdercreated the most talked abovi and widely esten food amiong Blacks, chitterlings.
The many problems facing us today were rare America and integration. Black suicides, disrespect to your elders, lack of parental control and an uinwilingness to work are not Biack traditions. Cursing in public by our youth, teenage girls strutting the streets with their babies and a damn if ! do, darnn if! don't attitude of far too many Blacks are not treditionat Black vatues. Though tess aducated, pre 60's adults may have done everything under the sun that was immoral, illegal and plain old Jumb, but they would rather die and go to hell with gasoline spread over their entire ody than bring pubtic shame to their family or community. Although those parents may have only finished the fifth or sixth grade, they pushed their children to get an education and made reat sacrifies to enable their children to go as far educationally as possible. And in many cases, their menial jobs did not bring in much money, and what

There are two faise theories that are tavit concoerning the Lord's Supper. (1) The Rocmen Catholic theory of "Transubstantiation", mooning that tien the priest prayn over the

The unleavened bread symbolizes Christ's pure sizless body that was broken on the crosa for us. The Word of God says in Matthew $26: 26$ "And as they were eating, Jesus took bread and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat this is my body." The Bible says in 1 Carinthians $11: 24$ "And whien he had given thanks,
