Monday morning. Eddie Richardson Center at The Bridge of Lubback opened its doors to 3 and 4 year-old children from lowincome families pre-school education, health services, and family support.

The Eddle Richardson Center is a Head Start program hosted by the South Plains Community Action Association. The SPCAA Head Start provides preschool education to 1,324 children in 12 counties of the South Plains through program and ISD hosted centers.

the former Posey Elementary School which now belongs to The Bridge of Lubbook. The Bridge of Lubbook is a nonprofit organization which provides services to the community such as a clothes closet, food vouchers, meals. family financial counseling and The "ROK" after school program.

The Eddie Richardson September 8, 2008, the Center is opening two weeks late due to a delay in the visit from the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services for licensing. The center has been ready since before the school year began and used the t time to further prepare for open-

Although tuition is free, Head Start Centers maintain the same quality as for-profit preschools and day cures. The centers must meet all Texas Department of Family and Protective Services regulations as well as the National Head Start performance standards which ensure Head Start sites The center is located in provide excellent services to enrolled children.

Children are examined and monstored for health and dental problems and referred to local clinics by registered nurses and LVN's when issues arise. This along with other school-rendiness services are provided to prepare children mentally, physically and societly for kindergarten.

Detroit Mayor Kilpatrick Pleads Guilty, Resigns

DETROIT (AP) -- Mayor probationary period, cannot run Kwame Kilpatrick pleaded guilty to felony charges years and loses his law license. Thursday in a sex scandal, foreing him out of office after moments after Wayne County months of defiantly holding onto his job leading the nation's Groner accepted the mayor's 11th-largest city. He was ordered jailed for four months and fined \$1 million. 'I lied under oath," Kilpatrick said in

The plea deal brings to an tence that would run at the same end a seven-months-long ordeal that has been a distriction for one of the nation's most troubled cities, which suffers from some of the highest home foreclosure and unemployment rates in the country, and has struggled for decades against population loss, high crime and meial tension.

The Detroit city charter automutically expels any mayor guilty of a felony.

A one-sentence letter signed by Kilpstrick and filed with the court states his cangnation will take effect Sept. 18.

City Council President Ken Cockrel Jr. will succeed Kilpstrick as mayor until a spccial election is held.

As part of Thursday's deal. the 38-year-old Denocest is to serve four months in jail and five years of probation. He also would pay the \$1 million in restitution over the five-year

Obama, launching his historic fall campaign for the White louse with an outdoor National Demogratic Convention extravaganza, pledged Thursday to "fix the broken politics in Weshington' after he defeats Republican John McCain in the fall.

responsible adult); and all household members' incomes by source; OR the household's food stamp or AFDC case number, if appropriate and the signature of an adult household member certilying that the information is correct. Applications may be submitted any time during the year. According to the free and reducedprice policy, Head Start stuff will review applications and determine eligibility. Parents or guardians dissatisfied with the ruling of the official may discuss the decision with the Texas Tech Health Specialist. Parents may request a formal appeal either orally or in writing by contacting:

Households must report increases of over \$50 per month or \$600 per year in household income, and decrease in household size. If a nousehold member becomes unempleyed or is the household size nerceses, the household should contact the contractor. These shanges may qualify children for the reduced-price meals or for free meals if the household's income falls to or below the levels shown above. AFDC/Food Stamp households must report termination of benefits. Some foster children are also eligible for free or reduced-price meals. A household with foster children should conact the contractor for more information. The information that households provide is confidential and will be used only to determine eligibility and verifying data.
