Getting Elected Is Only the Beginning

In an carlier column, I ex- scream when they run, and jets plained that, as long as our people will always roar when they fiy. nation's political offices, we have no grounds for complacency. To this day, I stand behind this conclusion. However, 1 should add
the following point of clarificathe following point of clarifica-
tion: Even if we do succeed in rectifying the imbalance of black representation in our nation's political offices, we absolutely cannot afford to be complacent.
For the obstacles to political For the obstacles to political
empowerment do not end at the empowerment do not end at the
ballot box; they merely take other forms. Some of these forms are obvious, such as the opposition of
certain congressmen in certain congressmen in the early
1980's to extending the 1965 1980's to extending the 1965
Voting Rights Act. However, I don't worry as much abour the
obvious obstacles as I do about those which are less obvious. Washington last week in in Washington last week in an
amendment to the 1982 Airport The amendment, concerning airport noise freemed hardly controversial. It proposed to take ten
percent of an airport's trust funds percent of an aisort trust funds
ard distribute it to nearby suburbs for small noise abatement projects if the U.S. Secretary of Transportation decided that the airport
authority had not made "reasonaauthority had not made "reasona-
ble progress" in developing an ble progress" in developing an
effective noise abatement proiect of its own. Yet upon close
scrutiny, the bill went to the heart of the friction between the urban and suburbàn communities of
Chicago and many other AmeriChicago and many other Ameri-
can cities. Black-white friction. As it stood, the noisereduction amendmeat would have given America's suburban com-
munities a potent tool in gumming munities a potent tool in gumming
the legislative machinery of the the legislative machinery of the
cities which they surround. For in its essence, the amendment enabied people in the suburbs to hold governments in the cities accountable for aircraft noise.
