Progress Made in Volunteer Game Preserve Movement

Game Warden O'Neil Here Monday Confering With Agent Concerning Work

Austin O'Neil of Wellington, state game warden, was in Memphis Monday confering with R. E. L. Pattillo, county agent, in regard to the establishment of a county-wide game preserve in Hall County.

Mr. Pattillo and Mr. O'Neil began the movement a little over a year ago by sending cards to all Hall County farmers requesting their cooperation in posting their farms for the conservation of wild birds.

In cooperation with the movement farmers are under no obligation nor have any specifications to follow. Recommendations are issued, suggesting that the farmers leave wide fence rows in their feed crops and collect brush piles

for nesting places. Birds, and particular quail and similar species, feed largely on insects, according to Mr. Pattillo, and had these birds abounded in Hall County from grass-hoppers would have been greatly reduced.

According to Mr. O'Neil, a regional representative of his department will be stationed in Amarillo soon to assist in carrying on this work of creating volunteer game preserves for birds in the Panhandle.

Mr. Pattillo reports that farmers in various parts of the county have stated that the birds have increased about 25 times since the preserve movement was started.
