Memphis Hospital had 1567 hospital days last year (1935) and with all the doctors co-operating they have agreed it should run 4000 hospital days per year and at the minimum charge of $\$ 4.00$ per day would far more than operate itself and absorb what the County is now paying out for the care of indigant patients.
