\$60,000 TO BE PAID UNEMPLOYED
TEXAS FIRST BENEFITS for unemployed, under
the new social security law, will total approx-
imately $\$ 60,000$ to some 9,000 eligible persons. The
average amount per person is reported to be $\$ 8$.
The amount is only part of the funds that have
been accumulating in the Treasury Department in
Washington from contributions by Texas employers
during the past two years. One out of every three
workers in Texas is qualified to receive benefits from
the funds when he becomes an unemployed.
This marks the first results of the Social Security
Act as a true benefit to the working man and should
see an increased number of workers and employers
complying with the law.
