FLEMINGTON, N. J., Jan. 4.—Colonel Charles A. Lindbergh today identified Bruno Richard Hauptmann as the man whose voice he heard in the Bronx cemetery when he paid through Dr. John F. Condon a \$50,000 ransom in a vain effort to get back his kidnaped baby.

"Since that night in Straymond's cemetery," the prosecutor asked, "did you hear the same voice?" "Yes."

"Whose was that voice?"

"Mr. Hauptmann's," Lindbergh replied.
