Mr. Page had also previously sold his ranch 5 miles north of Eldorado to Dock Kerr, this leaves Mr. Page out of the ranch and stock business.

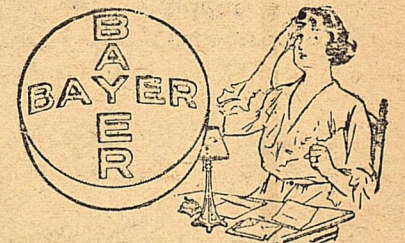

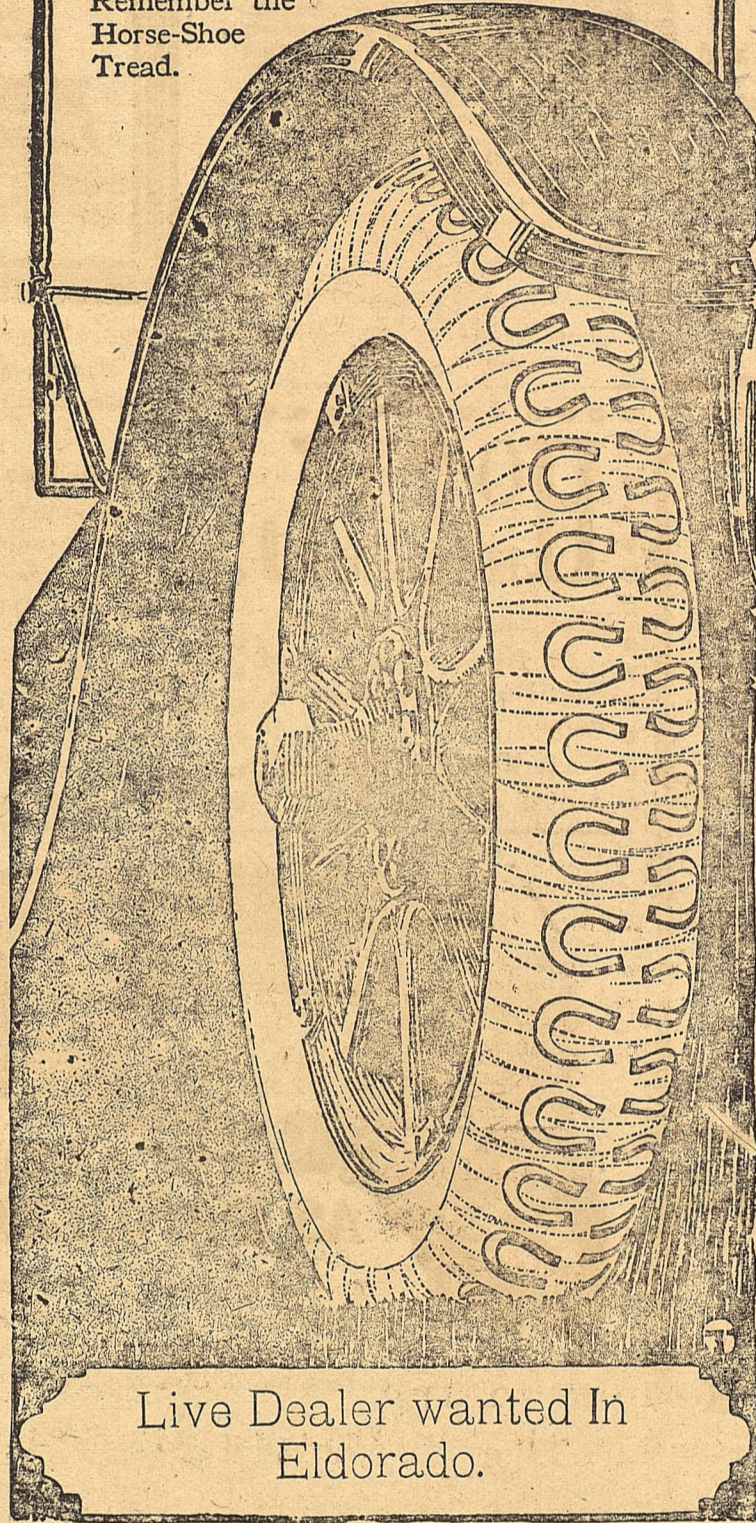
