TOM GREEN COUNTY LET ROAD WORK.

The Tom Green County Commissioners' Court has awarded to Herman R. Hicks of Houston and C. C. Smith of San Angelo, a \$262,000 contract for the building of ten miles of paved road on State Highway No. 9, a link in the Puget Sound-to-the-Gulf route. At the same time the court ordered a rock crusher, two tractors and other machinery, costing \$15,537 20.

Five miles of this road is on the Water Valley road and the other five miles is on the Wall road each beginning at San Angelo.
