Austin, Sept. 1.—Assistant Attorney General Stone ruled that women will be required to have a poll tax receipt only at primary elections. He said that in view of the amendment to the United States Constitution all women otherwise qualify to vote may vote in bond and general elections without being required to show a poll tax receipt or to have paid a poll tax.

## CIVIL WAR BONDS ROSE \$26.90 IN NINE YEARS LIBERTIES BETTER YET

"Holders of Liberty Bonds who are inexperienced in dealing in securities have been frequently stampeded into selling their bonds because they have fallen below the face value," said Dinsmore W. Hume, Federal District Director of Savings for the Eleventh Federal Reserve District. "When they recall paying \$100 for a bond that can be bought in the market for less, they are alarmed, fearing they made a bad investment and not infrequently have been induced to trade their government securities for those of less certain value on the promise of higher returns."

"Bonds will not remain at the present low prices. Civil war bonds sold in 1911 for \$81.20, nine years later they brought \$106.10, an increase of \$24.90 on each \$100 bond, or a raise of 30%. No one who knows anything of our history can be blind to the fact that the country is on a sounder financial basis than in 1911 and every indication points to a greater increase in prices of Liberty Bonds than Civil War bonds ever enjoyed. Wherefore, if those who bought Liberties because they wanted to support the government have as much financial understanding as they have patriotism, they will grab every bond they can carry at present market low prices; they are investments par excellence."

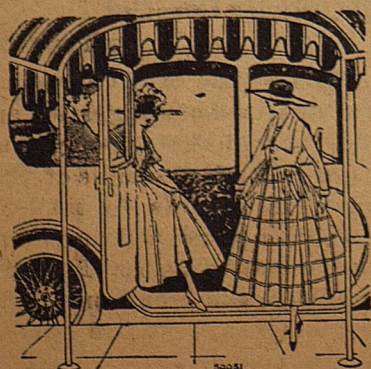

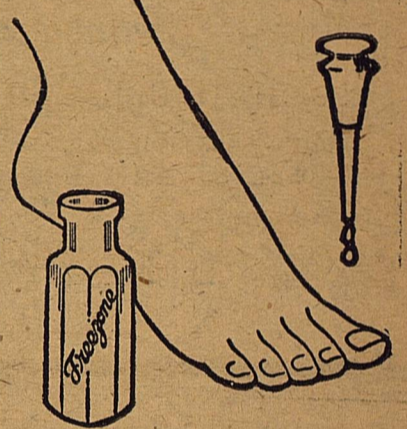

W. C. EASTLAND CANDIDATE FOR CONGRESS.

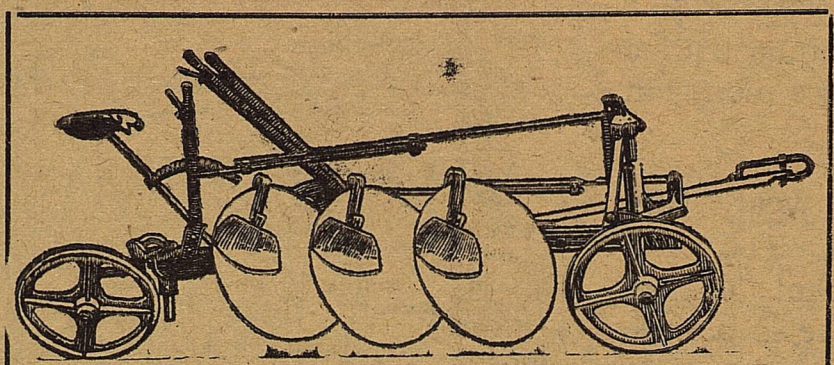

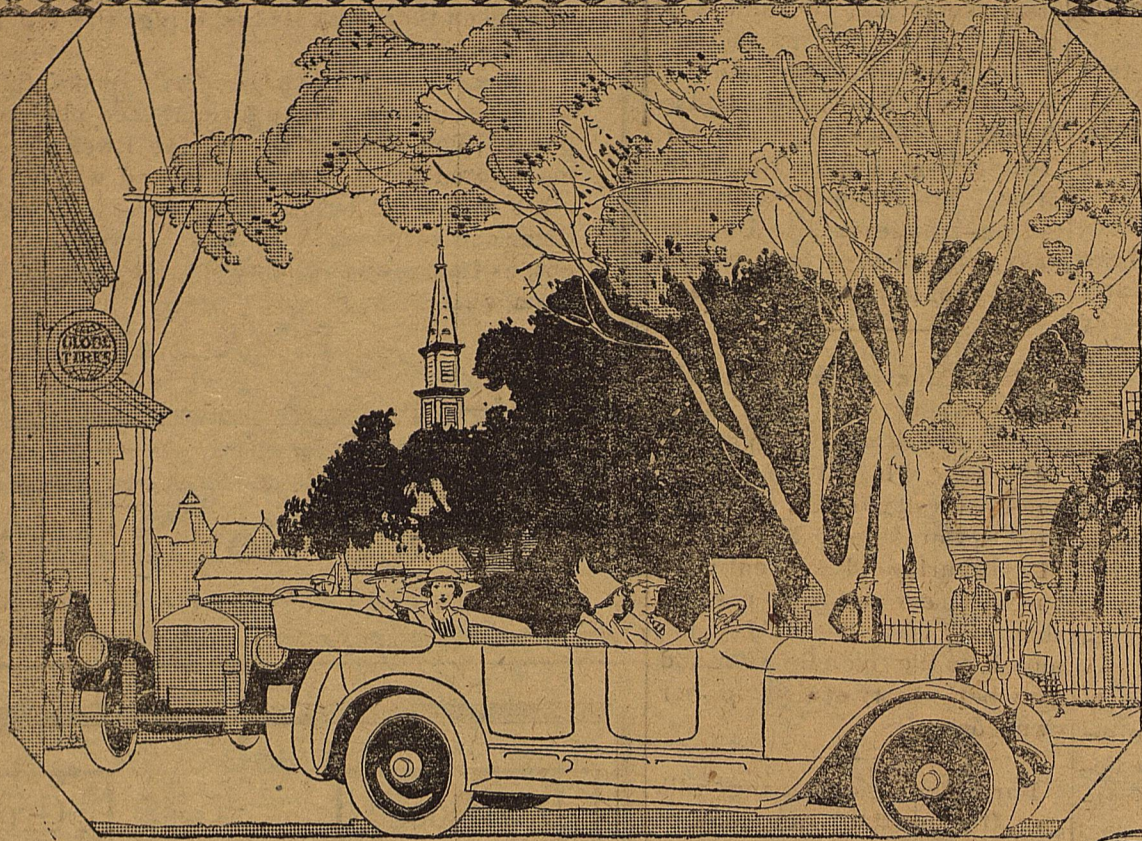
