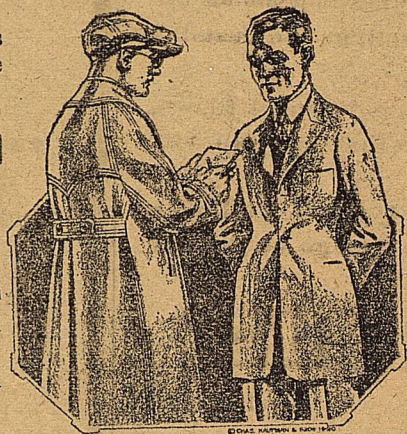

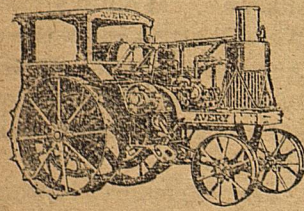

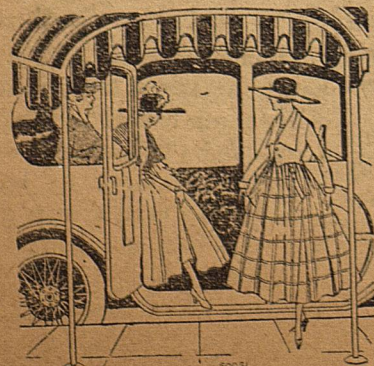

San Angelo is to pull off her big fair from October 26th to 31st. Get old Henry greased, up and full of gas, and lets go. This will be the biggest one San Angelo has ever had. And just think of the many nice things we can buy for our homes with the money we formerly threw away on booze. How nice it is to think of the San Angelo of today.

There seems to be some real railroad news in the air again, but we have talked so much about it in the past that we are a bit afraid to say anything now, but our railroad committee is busy this week, and will soon have the deed to the right-of-way back in the hands of the local organization, of which W. L. Aldwell, of Sonora, is chairman, and W. O. Alexander, of Eldorado, is secretary.

This organization has already had two propositions from promoters to build a road they call the Rio Grande, San Saba & Llano Valley from San Angelo to Sterling City and from Miles to Paint Rock.

L. B. Williams of Houston has submitted a tentative contract, in which he agrees to for \$200,000.00 and right-of-way to lay 60-pound steel from San Angelo to Sonora.

It seems likely that something will develop in railroad building whereby Eldorado will become a railroad town. No town in West Texas would develop faster than Eldorado, for we have the ideal stockfarming section of Texas, none better, and no time in the history of Eldorado was there a better time to invest in Eldorado town property. Of course it is higher now than two years ago, but it will advance again. Our farm land is also a live one, our rough ranch land is near the top.

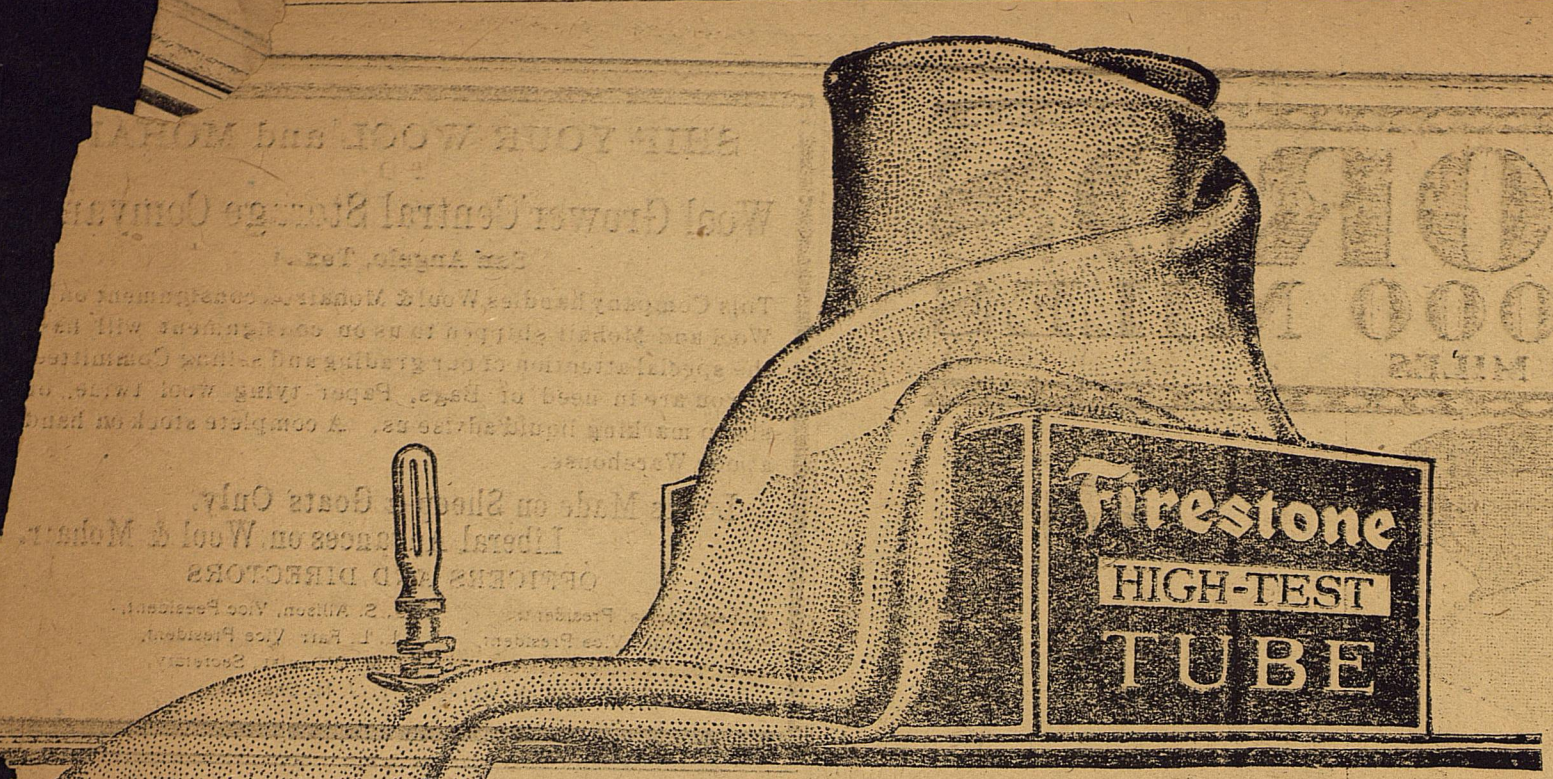

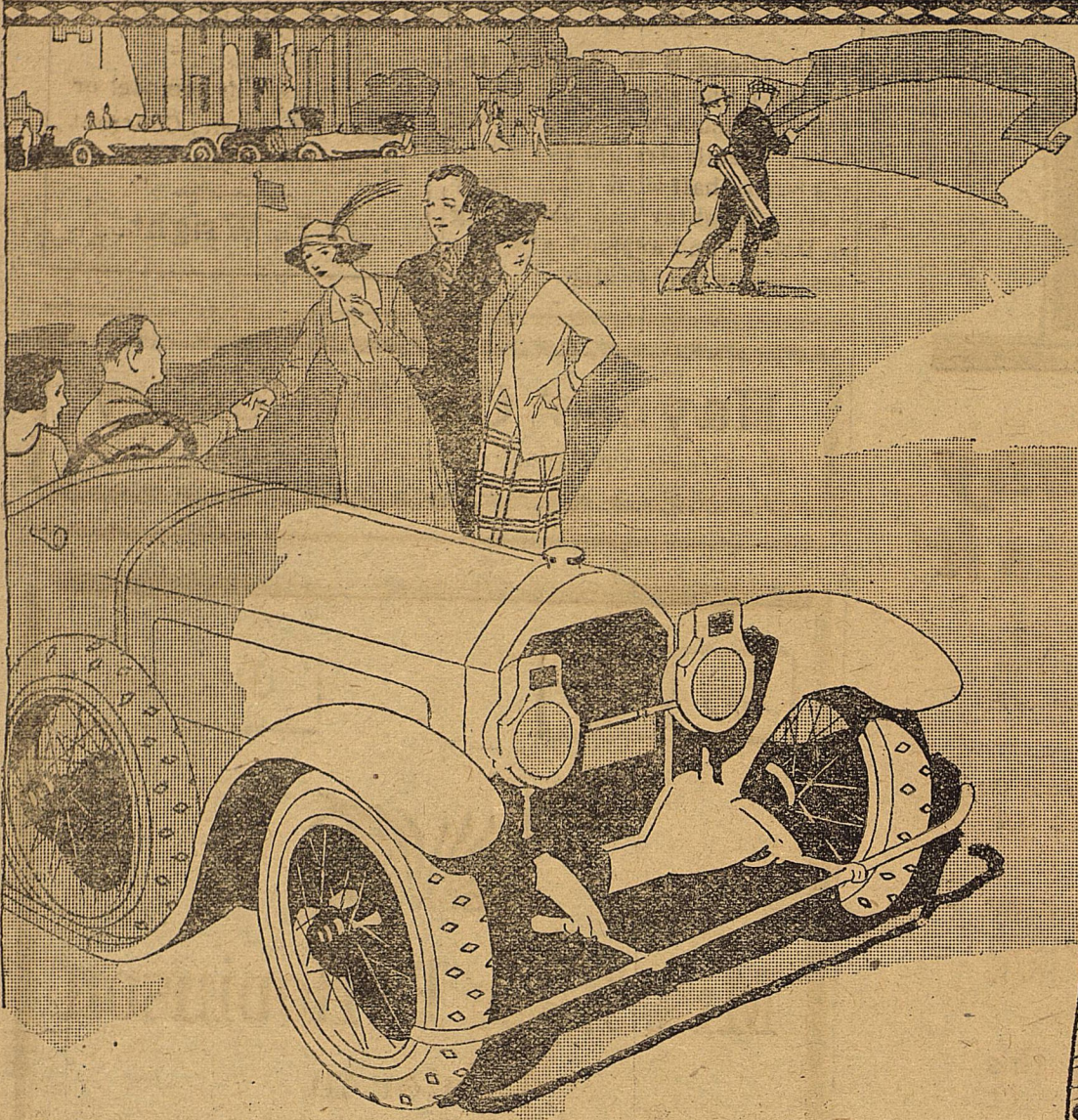

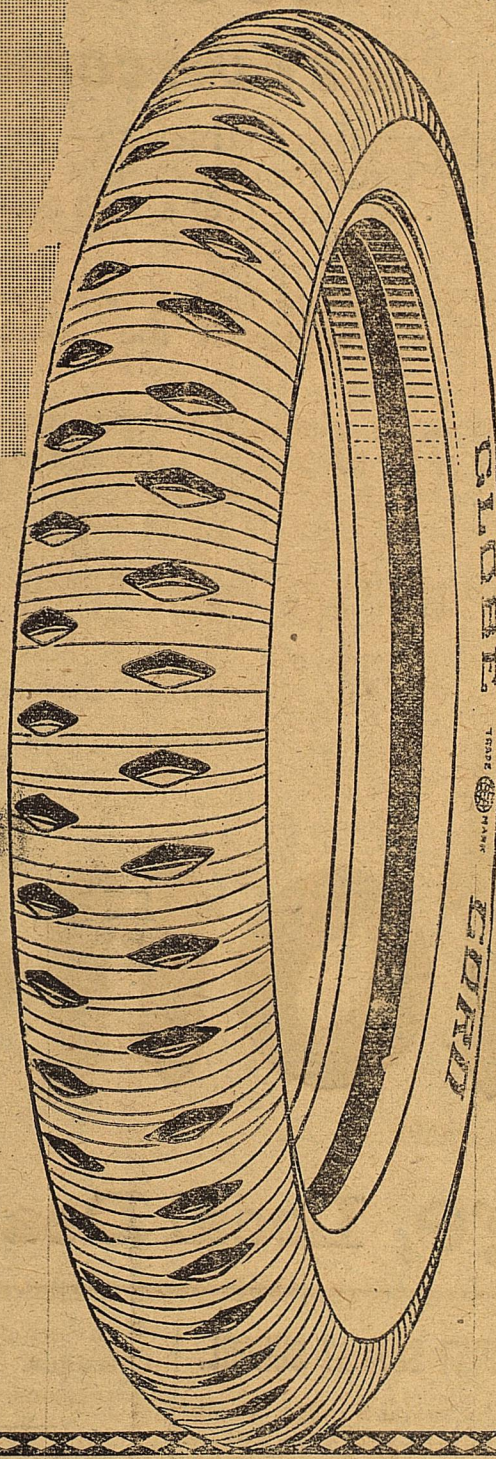
