J. A. Holland was here from Brady Tuesday looking after his farm interest.

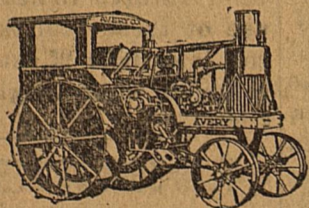

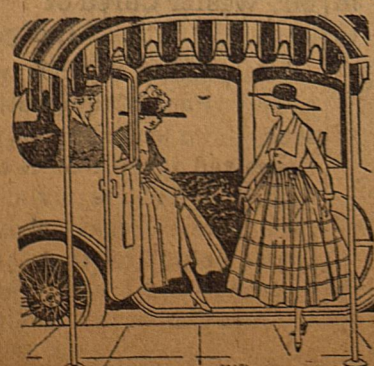

### ELTON JONES HAS PAINFUL ACCIDENT.

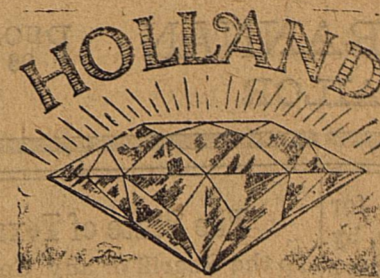

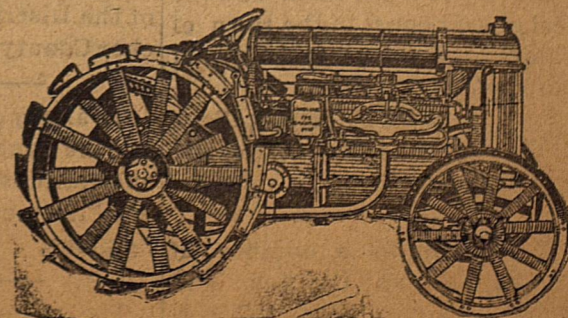
