





CHRISTMAS WEEK IN ENGLAND


Time When Scattered Families Are United and Tender Memories Are Revived.



Feeding the Ghosts

A pure-bred shows more gain in tender, wellflavored meat from 100 pounds of feed, because, with generations of good breeding and good feeding back of him, he is haunted by none of the scrub's ghosts.


