CHALLENGE TO ALL TEXAS DELEGATION.

To all my 17 colleagues who are Congressmen from Texas:

We serve not ourselves but the people.

For prudential reasons the Congress is to adjourn Nov. 24th. It meets again Dec. 5th. Emboldened with the belief that I have justice on my side, and being therefore thrice armed, but wholly without malice or unkind feeling toward any, I hereby challenge you, singly and collectively, to meet me during said interim in joint debate in the cities of Dallas, Fort Worth, Houston, Galveston, Austin, San Antonio, Waco, Amarillo and El Paso, the proceedings of Congress, and the records and deportment of ourselves and Colleagues, to be embraced within the issue, with three hours to each debate, half time allotted to me, and the other half to be used by any one or all of your number, as you select. Admission is to be free, but to prevent neither having an advantage in seating the audience, you are to distribute one half the seats, and I the other. We are to prorate expense of renting auditoriums. This challenge is for prompt acceptance only, so that I may arrange plans for the recess. Grant me this boon.

Credit has been the ruin of this entire section. Credit is the curse of the average person to whom it is given; it is the ruin of the merchant, and it is a heavy additional tax upon the person who pays cash. If a merchant loses his goods through inability to get pay for them, it means that the customer who does pay must pay more for what he gets.—Ozona Stockman.

There are two kinds of credit, one bad and one good. The good sort is that which is justified by a seasonal need; the bad sort is that which is justified by nothing save the vanity or the poor judgment of the borrower. There is a type of economist, and that type gets into the public prints often, which assumes that credit is the lodestone of commercial success. Of course it isn't. Credit kills as many as it saves. Those who borrow money with which to speculate, either ticker tape speculation or speculation in goods, hardly ever fail to bankrupt themselves and, simultaneously, injure somebody else. There are cattlemen in the Ozona brother's territory who own large herds of cattle on which there are liens amounting to more than the cattle would sell for at the stockyards. They are not wholly to blame, for cattle went down too far and too soon. But if some of those men had been content with 1,000 head, with pasture to match, instead of expanding to 5,000 or 10,000 head with the use of borrowed money, they would be independent today. They could live easily on their own. It is so with dozens of different operations. It is so with some farmers who wanted to own 500 acres instead of owning 100. It is so with some merchants, who wanted a big store with big debts rather than a little store clear of debt. It was so of some newspaper publishers, who wanted a metropolitan printing plant plastered with mortgages in preference to a modest outfit owned and paid for. It was so with some bankers, who borrowed at 6 or 7 per cent to lend at 8 or 10. It was so with some housewives, who chose to owe for an electric sweeper when they might have paid for a broom.—Dallas News

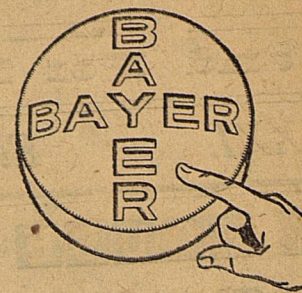

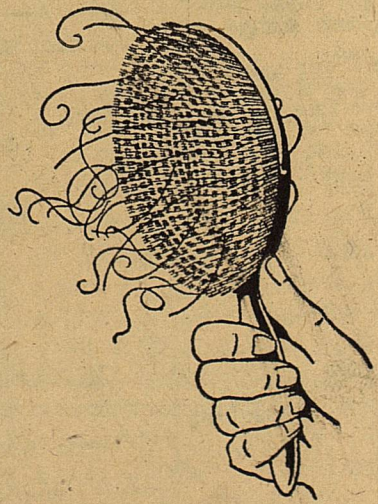
