### MARTIAL LAW EXTENDED IN FREESTONE COUNTY.

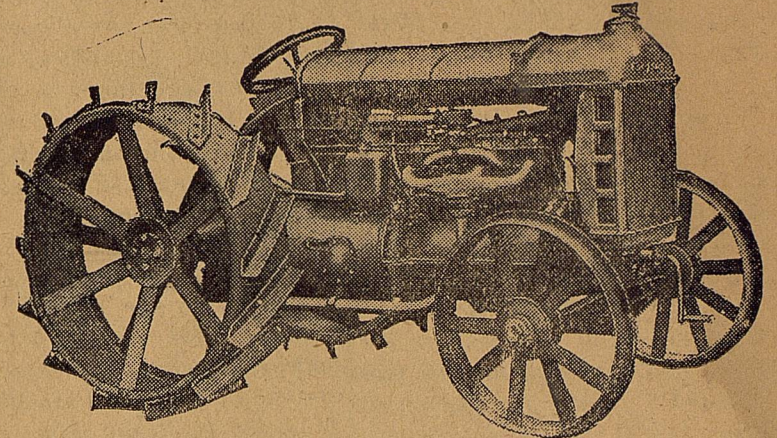

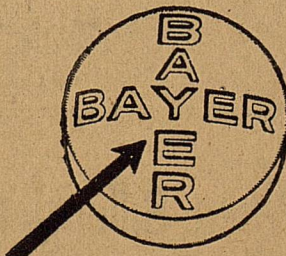

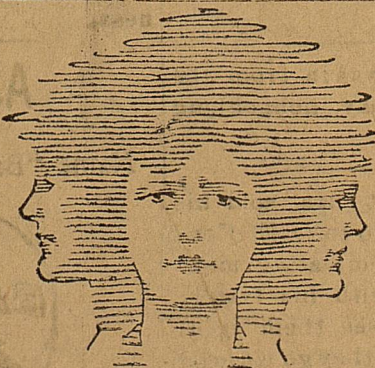
