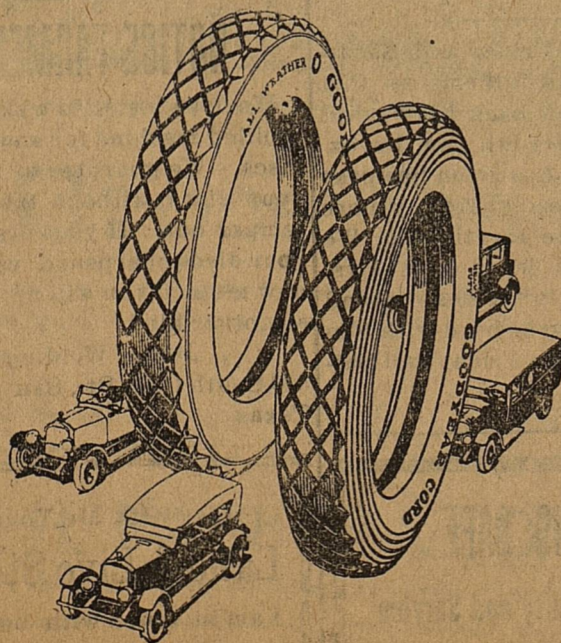

COLQUITT ASKS THAT SESSION BE CALLED

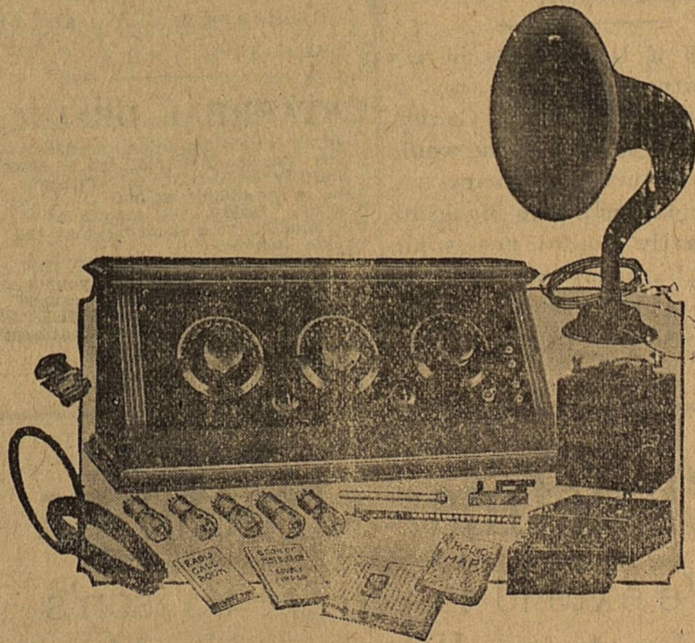
"Give the people a chance to know the truth," former Governor O. B. Colquitt urged Lee Shatterwhite, Speaker of the House, in answer to a telegram from the Speaker asking him to come to Austin Monday for a conference on the legislative situation. He also asserts that there is no question of the legality of warrants to pay expenses of a called session of the Legislature. He said he would not be able to go to Austin.

"I am sure the people want and expect an extra session to investigate matters on which they are demanding more information. Somebody is responsible for the shameless waste of public money, and the responsibility should be ascertained and fixed," the former Governor's answer to the Speaker said.

"The law imposes on you the duty of calling the session if you have the requisite number of requests of members of the House to do so, and there is no question of the right to issue warrants in payment of the expense of the session"

Members, by accepting election are under the duty of answering the call and members who hold themselves ready, resolutely to discharge that public duty, will answer the call. Those who refuse to attend because they have served private interest to the public injury should be expelled and let the people elect others in their stead

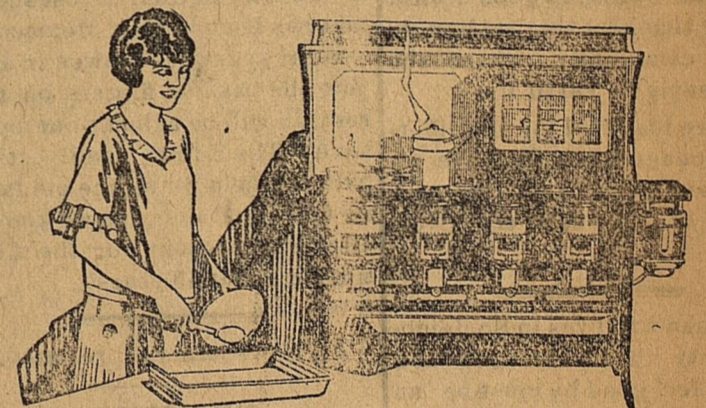

It is more blessed to give than to receive, so send some unfortunate one, some thing that will make them feel better.

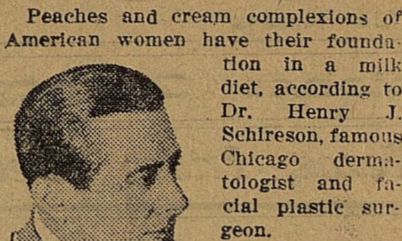

"Authorities agree that milk is the most nearly perfect food but it is an extremely delicate one as well. Heat sufficient to kill all bacteria is the essential of absolutely pure and sterile milk. One of the advantages of evaporated milk, which is simply fresh cow's milk with sixty per cent of the water removed, is that it is entirely sterile and is more easily assimilated than ordinary market milk."

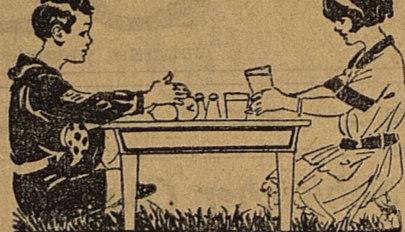

**Nourishing Drink
for Children**



BABIES and children, the same as adults, grow weary of being fed the same food in the same way each day. It is true that most children take naturally to milk, but that does not mean that they must be fed it ad nauseam. On the contrary, that is the very thing to be avoided.

Pediatricians advise consumption by children of a quart of milk a day in one form or another. This does not mean skim milk, but whole milk, for the skimmed product is lacking both in butter fat and the essential food element known as vitamin A, which is found in butter fat. Many mothers do not appreciate that removal of cream from the top of a bottle of milk results in skim milk.

In evaporated milk, a product recommended by many leading doctors for the use of infants and children and which is simply pure cow's milk sterilized in cans and with sixty per cent of the water removed, there is no cream line. The milk in the top of a can is the same as it is in the bottom of the container. This results from a process called homogenization, in which the fat globules in the milk are broken up into such microscopic bits that they remain in homogeneous suspension. Every drop of homogenized milk has a buttery taste because it contains butter fat. For this reason, in evaporated milk there is none of the fat taste one finds in drinking from the bottom of a bottle of market milk.

In order to avoid feeding the baby or child plain milk three or four times a day, many authorities recommend the use of a mixture of fruit juice and milk, a highly palatable and refreshing drink.

Following is a recipe worked out by experts for an orange-milk drink: Mix in a fruit jar 3/4 of a cupful of orange juice, 1/4 of a cupful of evaporated milk, three teaspoonfuls of sugar, 1/2 teaspoonful of lemon juice and a few grains of salt. Shake well before serving.

Rank Health With
Three "Rs" Is Plea

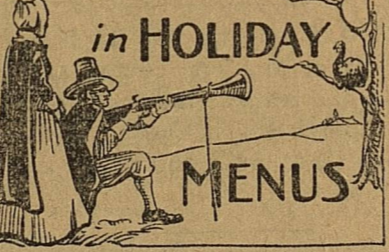
As an educational subject for children, health should hold equal rank with the three "Rs" in the curriculum of public schools. Doctors declare that without a healthy, sturdy body it is impossible for the child to have a healthy, happy mind.

Neglect of childhood defects may result in permanent physical impairment later on. Many childhood ills are traceable directly to malnutrition. High school students especially need a variety in foods for at this age their growth is rapid. The protein or "building food" should be abundant for high school boys and girls. When they buy their luncheons, high school pupils are apt to display a preference for chocolate sodas, cream puffs and candy. An appetizing luncheon put up at home is much to be preferred to the sort the boy or girl might obtain at the corner store near the school.

Meat is all right for the school luncheon but it should be put up in tempting form. If sliced thin it is more appetizing in sandwiches than if in thick pieces. Beverages or soup may be carried in thermos bottles but the bottles must be carefully washed and aired daily after using. Milk is recommended for an important place in the boy's or girl's diet because of its proteins, minerals, phosphorus and calcium, necessary for the development of the body and in the case of calcium and phosphorus for the building of bone and teeth. Evaporated milk has come into favor as a health builder for children as well as adults because by removal of 60 per cent of the water it is rendered more than twice as rich in food value as ordinary milk and by a process called homogenizing more digestible than bottled market milk.

Crisp lettuce and celery, carefully washed and dried, may be so wrapped in oil paper that they will be fresh and in good condition at lunch time. Lettuce should not be used in sandwiches for wilted lettuce is almost indigestible.

Of course, the home manager doesn't want to serve the same thing each year and as a consequence, she spends hours in hunting recipes and planning new things in the menu line.

The appended menus for the holiday dinner and supper may prove a welcome change to your family.

- Supper.**
- Cream of Tomato Soup Croutons
 - Fruit Salad With Whipped Cream Sauce
 - Cheese Crackers Assorted Cakes
 - Nuts Chocolate
 - Pumpkin Pie.
- 1 1/2 cups pumpkin 1/4 cup water
1 cup strained juice orange
1/2 cup brown 1/4 tsp. soda
1 cup sugar 1 tsp. ginger
2 eggs 1 tsp. cinnamon
1 cup evaporated 1/4 tsp. salt
milk
- Add the sugar and seasoning to the pumpkin, then add the slightly beaten eggs, milk and water. Stir till well blended and pour in a deep crust-lined pan. Bake at 450 degrees Fahrenheit for first 10 minutes and 300 degrees Fahrenheit for 50 minutes.
- Cauliflower au Gratin.**
- Remove leaves and trim off the stalk from large cauliflower. Soak in a solution of 1 tsp. vinegar, 1 tsp. salt and a quart of water for 15 minutes to remove dirt and insects. Cook whole, stem up, in boiling salted water for seven minutes. Place cauliflower in an oiled baking dish, pour over a thin evaporated milk white sauce and cover with buttered crumbs and grated cheese. Brown in a moderate oven. This serves six.
- Cream of Tomato Soup.**
- 1 No. 3 can tomato 1 tsp. sugar
 - 10 lbs 1 1/2 tsp. salt
 - 4 sprigs parsley 1/4 tsp. soda
 - 1/2 tsp. thyme 2 cups evaporated
 - 1 bay leaf milk diluted
 - 1 tsp. peppercorns with
 - 6 cloves 2 cups water
 - 2 slices onion 2 tsp. flour
 - 2 tsp. butter
- Make a white sauce of the diluted evaporated milk, the butter and flour. Cook the tomatoes with the seasonings for five minutes and strain. There should be 3/4 cups of pulp. Add soda to pulp and combine with the hot white sauce. Pour immediately into thermos bottle.
- Whipped Cream Sauce.**
- Three-fourths cup evaporated milk, 1 cup whipping cream, 1/2 cup powdered sugar.
- Chill the cream and evaporated milk. Combine and whip until stiff. Fold in the sugar and keep chilled until ready to serve.

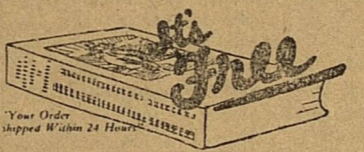

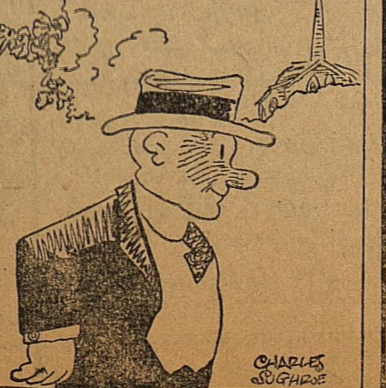

HEALTH

Sugar is the preservative used in manufacturing the condensed product, while heat only is the preservative for evaporated milk. For this reason the evaporated product may be used in any way in which market milk is used.
