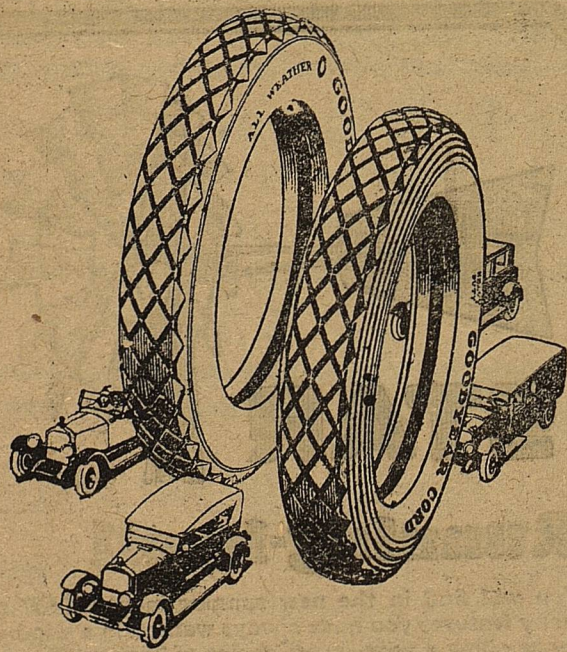

J. B. BRUTON DEAD.

Sunday morning our community was saddened by the death of J. B. Bruton, a worthy stock-farmer just South of El Dorado three miles.

Mr. Bruton was born in Tarrant County Texas, February 17, 1859, and would have been 66 years of age next month, he was married to Miss Mattie Osborne December 23rd 1881, and to this union were born 8 sons and 4 daughters, most of whom were present. He united with the Baptist church 33 years ago and has been a faithful servant for his master ever since.

Mr. Bruton moved to El Dorado in 1916, from Frost Texas, although he had previously bought some land here, which was in charge of his son W. E. Bruton, up to his coming.

Mr Bruton made many friends since his coming here by the stand he took for the things that stood for right.

The funeral services were held at the First Baptist Church Monday morning, the service was conducted by Brother W. P. Ray, after which the remains were laid to rest in the El Dorado Cemetery.

Deceased has been suffering from an attack of paralysis for several months, and suffered another, attack Sunday morning which caused his death.

SCHOOL DISTRICT ACT BY LEGISLATURE TO BE CONTESTED

Joe Tisdale, Geo. E. Baugh and Ike Honig Are Plaintiffs.

Friday, Robert T. Neill, of the firm of Hill, Neill & Hill of San Angelo, filed an injunction against Sheriff Luedeke and the Trustees of the El Dorado Independent School District, naming Joe Tisdale, George E. Baugh and Ike Honig, as plaintiffs. The suit filed is to prevent the School District from collecting a 75 cent tax levied against the plaintiffs, et al, property in the district, or was in the District when the school bonds were voted and sold. Judge J. F. Sutton granted a temporary injunction and set Saturday January 23rd, to hear the complaint.

If the Plaintiffs are successful in their suit it will affect about 100,000 acres of land in the District,

We welcome Mr. Sharp to our city and trust that he will be a valuable asset to same.

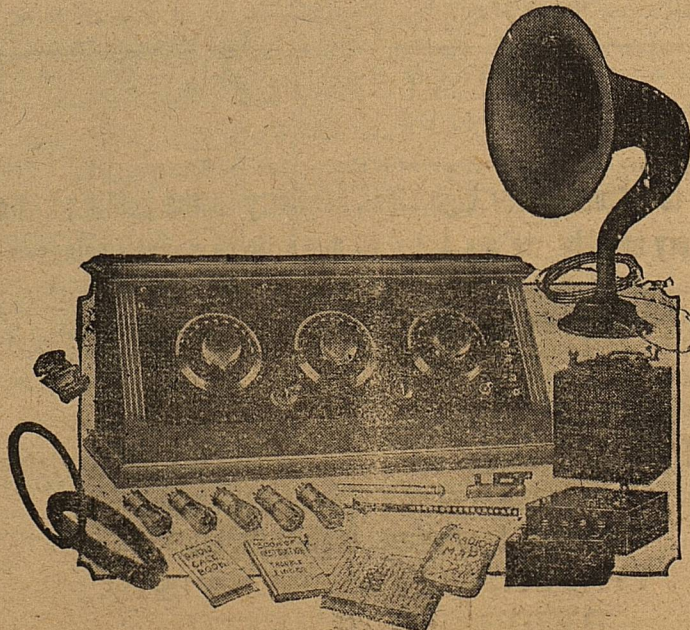
ELDORADO WELL REPRESENTED IN SIMMONS U.

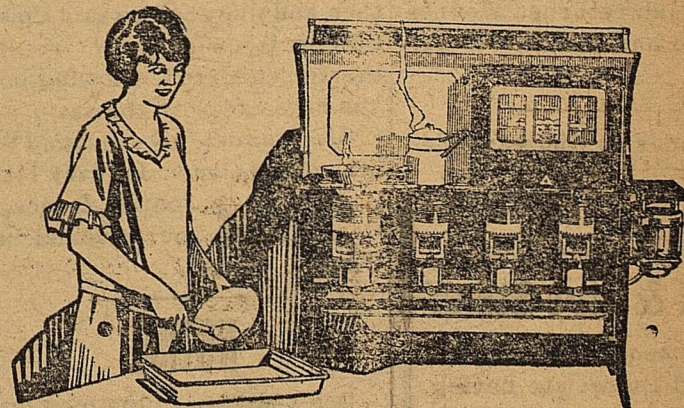
