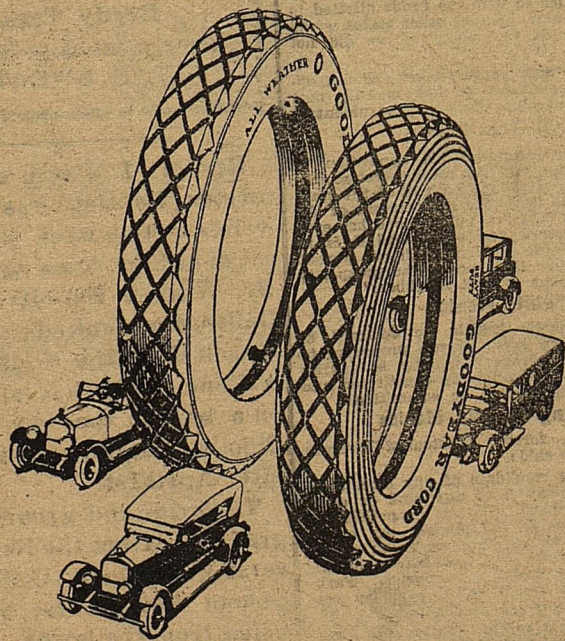

## A REAL MAN TO RUN FOR GOVERNOR.

Rev. O. F. Zimmerman of Naples Offers for the Position.

The Rev. O. F. Zimmerman of Naples, known as "Zim, the Tithing Evangelist," says he is willing to make the race for governor if the people wanted him to.

He said in part. If I am called to deliver Texas I shall run on the strength of God, and my appeal shall be to the God-loving, God-fearing men and women of Texas to come to His help against the ring-ruled political organization that now controls Texas.

I was born in South Carolina June 29, 1875. My father was and honored member of the South Carolina conference for fifty years, I am a Methodist minister, having been a member of the Texas conference for 20 years. During the last ten years I have been a conference appointed evangelist, and am known from border to border as "Zim, the Tithing Evangelist." My record has been before my brethren of the Texas ministry for twenty years and is open for inspection, especially to Jim Ferguson, our proxy Governor. Moody and Davidson helped to foster the Ferguson on Texas for Governor and this is enough to cause Texas to turn elsewhere for a chief executive.

Our present primary law is exactly what Texas needs with one exception. I stand squarely for an amendment that shall eliminate all foreign votes from Texas primary.

Texas does not need a civil service commission. Texas needs to elect a governor they can trust to put clean, God-fearing men and women in the various State departments.

As your governor I shall keep a weather eye on our Highway Commission. I shall oppose any road contract that is not underwritten by the County Commissioners of the county through which it passes and I guarantee you that the moneys expended shall be directed under their supervision. We need a State Highway Department to outline and outlay, but we also need our own home folks to see that we get our money's worth.

As your Governor I shall take a burden from the back of the oiler and put it squarely on the back of the luxury-gorged politician and criminal. I promise you without reservation to cut the taxes of this State 50 per cent. Can the hard-fisted sons of labor in Texas say they get anything whatever in return for the taxes wrung out of them? No. We pay for protection from the criminal element and the doors of our penitentiary are opened and they are turned loose on us to prey as they will. None dare say our road tax money is protected. We are gouged and promised, but little do we get. We are promised laws and law enforcement, but we are the laughing stock of America. As your Governor I shall turn your penitentiary system into a gold mine. Every "jelly bean" politician shall be eliminated from the State pay roll. A Ford is about the only luxury some of our hard-working farmers and other laborers have. I shall remove all taxes on your little car and put them on Lynch Davidson's.

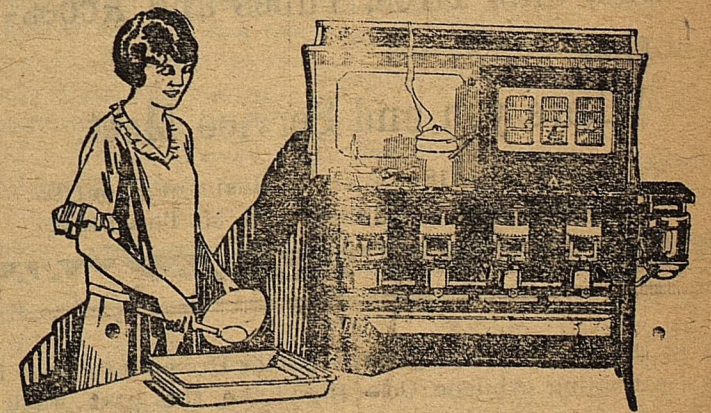

**TAKE CARE OF YOUR WOOL.**

- 1st. Prepare and keep a clean platform.
  - 2nd. Keep all dirt, manure, trash etc. out of the wool.
  - 3rd. Tie each fleece (12 months) separate and as close as possible with the flesh side out.
  - 4th. Put about 200 pounds in each bag.
  - 5th. Do not mix course and fine wool in the same bag, sack separate.
  - 6th. Put old ewe wool in separate Bags.
  - 7th. Tag, or at least remove a reasonable amount of the bad tags.
  - 8th. Do not allow the shearers to drag the sheep through the dirt to platform.
  - 9th. Sew the bags close and tight and make them neatly.
  - 10th. Keep wool dry, and do not let it lie in the dust.
- When your wool is shown to the buyer, the bag is opened from end to end and if it has been properly put up it will look white and clean, and the first impression made on the buyer is a good one, and your wool brings what it is worth. The opposite is true however, if the wool looks black and dirty, and is full of dirt and tags. It pays to take care of the wool.
- Wool as you must know is sold on scoured basis (quality of course counts) and you can readily see that the more dirt and grease there is in a pound the less wool there is in that pound, and therefore the less it is worth per pound. (in the dirt.)
- I am making the above statements, from actual observation and experience during the seventeen years which I have been connected with the wool selling business, and if you will carry out the suggestions here made I am sure it will be to your interest.

**LEWIS RODGERS DIES.**

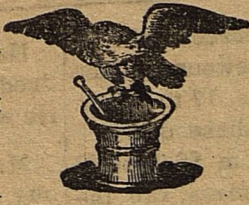
News reached El Dorado Thurs day morning, stating that Lewis Rodgers who was operated on last week at a San Angelo Sanitarium, died Wednesday night.
