



RARE OPERATION SAVES GIRL'S LIFE

Food Enters Her Stomach Through a Tube.

Indianapolis, Ind .- A long fight for the life of thirtzen-year-old Beatrice McCrary of Rushville, Ind., has been won and the girl will live and thrive, as the result of a daring and unusual operation.


Food is taken into the girl's stomach through a tube through the chest connected with the stomach. The child, ten years ago, swallowed a quantity of lye and the scars in the passageway from her mouth had become so constricted that it was impossible for solid foods to pass. To keep her from starving, a severe

operation dilating the passageway from the mouth was performed fortythree times, records show. This operation was so painful that

a general anesthesia was necessary each time. Following the operations the girl would be able to take food for a time until the burn scars again would close the passage. The child had suffered the pangs of hunger many times and she had learned to know the horror of a painful siege on the operating table.

The name of the surgeon to whom the operation was intrusted was not made public. The operation was carried out by making an incision through the chest wall and stitching an opening in the stomach wall to the borders of this incision, leaving an opening to the stomach from the exterior.

For several days after the operation the life of the little patient hung in the balance, but with the healing of the wound, and the introduction of food through the new route, recovery calls upon the legal candidate to





manded that their youngest brother be brought as a proof of the truthfulness of their word.

2. He kept Simeon as a hostage. Because he feared God he sent the rest home with provisions for their families.

3. Benjamin's peril (44:2,12). By a clever device Joseph's cup was placed in Benjamin's sack and was used as an occasion for bringing them back on the charge of theft. Convicted of their sins Judah pleaded for the release of Benjamin.

III. Judah's Plea (44:18-34).

For turning away of Joseph's anger (v. 18). He recited the history of the family and their coming to Egypt and appealed on the basis of the effect upon Jacob, their father, if Benjamin was not permitted to accompany them home.

 That he himself might be kept in slavery instead of Benjamin (v. 33).
IV. Joseph Reveals Himself to His Brethren (45:1-15).

1. He declares his identity (vv. 1-3). This act on the part of Joseph troubled them. It ought to have made them glad. This not only affords a beautiful example of forgiving love, but most beautifully illustrates Christ's dealing with His brethren, the Jews.

2. He bids his brethren come near (vv. 4-8).

When he revealed himself to his brethren, the remembrance of their sins pierced them through. Joseph's first question was about his father, showing that his desire was to put their thoughts far away from their crime. He invited them to come near to him and assured them that God had overruled their crime for their saivation.

3. Joseph sends his brethren away with good news (vv. 9-15).

As soon as Joseph's brethren knew him and were reconciled to him, they were sent with the glad tidings to their father. As soon as the Jewa come to know Jesus Christ as their Messiah, He will send them away to the ends of the earth with the good news of His saving grace.
