DIET FOR DIABETICS
by W.W. Beuer, M.D.

| Nutrition can be discussed in general terms for normal people. For those with illnesses or metaFor those with illnesses or meta- bolic deficiencies, the diet must be "tailored" to each individual, just as a well-fitted garment must be. Diet for diabeties falls into certain general principles, but the details must be: <br> a) advised by the attending physician after physical ex- amination, history of illness, and laboratory tests; <br> closely supervised at intervals varying with the sever ity of the condition; and modified from time to as conditions change. Nature of Diabetes <br> Diabetes is an inability of the body to cope with the chemical in the body. It is due to deficiency in a secretion produced by specialized cells in the pancreas, islands of Langerhans. The secretion is called insulin. <br> While diabetes is a defficiency in sugar metabolism, it involves other classes of foods. Starches are quickly converted into sugar; proteins in excess of needs are also changed into sugar. The handeficiency in sugar chemistry. It is obvious that the entire diet must be controlled. <br> These controls usually involve: <br> a) reduction in total calories, except where body weights diabetics are overweight); <br> b) elimination of all sugar as such; | c) restriction of starchy foods; dietary needs. <br> In addition to dietary controls, diabetics may require injections of insulin, or in the case of older and milder cases, one of the pills which help metabolize sugar. These pills are not insulin. Insulin must be injected. <br> Must Have Adequate Diet <br> Diabetics, like everyone else, order to maintain health and strength. The diabetic diet, in quantity control and sugar elim. ination, stresses the adequacy of protein intake.
